## City of Residence

While Culinary Arts students came from all parts of Oakland and Wayne Counties, the largest group of students hailed from Detroit (n=12) during the Winter 2001 term, five of whom were new Culinary Arts students. Other cities included Pontiac, Southfield, Ferndale, Royal Oak, and Rochester Hills.

In the Spring 2000 and Summer 2000 semesters, most students overall claim Southfield as their city of residence. However, for Fall 2000 and Winter 2001, most students were from Waterford.

## Curriculum

Overall, most students enrolled at OCC are Undecided. The more popular programs include: BUS, CIS, GEN, GUE, and LIB.

Fall 2000 had 155 students enrolled in the CUL program, 37 of whom were new students. Winter 2001 had 150 CUL students, with 31 new students.
