- I. Welcome/Introductions of Guest Administration C. Roman:
  - Dr. Roman welcomed everyone to the Community Assembly.

## II. Announcements/Updates

- A. Campus Conversations C. Roman reported:

- B. Safety Concerns B. Matthews reported:
  - There have been missing or misplaced items recently in Woodland Hall offices. Items

    party.
  - Make sure that doors are kept locked at all times.
  - For reporting purposes, make sure each individual files their own report.
