

Michigan Church Plans New Work in Vietnam

ROYAL OAK, Mich. — The church meeting at 115 S. Campbell in Royal Oak, has determined to send a missionary to Vietnam by the end of 1961. Vietnam, formerly known as Indo-China, has some 25 million people.

This congregation is interested in hearing from brethren who might be able to participate with them in the cause of sending the gospel to Saigon, the metropolis of this area.

Indo-China is one of the strategic points from which the gospel can spread back into China. It is the area over which the French forces and the Communists fought a few years ago which resulted in the dividing of the country into Northern and Southern Vietnam.

Those going to Vietnam should study in the French language due to the fact that the country was ruled over by the French for many years. All of
