"In 1928 the Hamilton Boulevard Church of Christ purchased some lots near Outer Drive and Grand River and started to erect a church building to be used as a mission by a group of their young people. This project was condemned by the city of Detroit as it was a restricted zone. No further effort was made by the Hamilton congregation to start a new church, but these young people did not lose their zeal and when the opportunity presented itself to start a church in Dearborn they readily accepted the challenge.
