The college administration is generally in support of college-wide wireless coverage for classrooms and administrative areas where appropriate and feasible. We could envision deploying an access point in every classroom where wireless would be of value to the learning environment.

Recognizing this is a major undertaking both in manpower and hardware costs this would need collective input from the Technology Management Committee as well as the College Academic Master Plan committee for further review and consideration.

- Learning-Ready Classroom (1/26)
 1. The College Administration in conjunction with faculty departments, IT and facilities personnel should survey all classrooms on all campuses and identify current problems that need to be addresses immediately in order to make the classroom learning-ready.

To expedite the repair of any outstanding issues with classroom operation affecting learning it is recommended that faculty members immediately contact the IT Support Center (for IT issues), and/or the Facilities Staff (for Facilities issues) through existing reporting procedures. College Senate could work with IR to conduct a survey.
 2. A pre-semester checklist for learning-ready classrooms should be developed (an example was provided).

IT and Facilities staff on each campus currently use local procedures to maintain classrooms. IT will investigate the feasibility of college-wide checklists.

3. The checklist should be used to assess every classroom on every campus before the beginning of the semester, and the results should be shared with Campus Facilities Committees on a regular basis.

The checklists from College Senate will be reviewed and incorporated or implemented where feasible.
