## Large crowd shares annual festivities of Homecoming

Queen candidates entered the gym for the halftime ceremonies through a tunnel of candlebearers. Terry Potter of Flushing, Michigan was crowned Homecoming Queen by MCC President Fletcher. The combined chorus, made up of over eight hundred singers, spent several hours in rehearsal with Dr. Howard Swan, a noted choral conductor from Los Angeles, California. On Saturday evening, the combined chorus presented a spectacular performance in addition to selections by the individual groups.

En route to Arkansas, the chorus appeared in Cincinnati, Ohio. On the return trip to Michigan, they performed for churches in St. Louis, Missouri and Indianapolis, Indiana, as well as the Indianapolis Christian School.
