Applicants will need to submit the application along with official college transcripts, 2 letters of recommendation, an unencumbered Michigan RN license and a one page letter describing your career plans and philosophy of nursing care. Applicants can apply for financial aid online by completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid. Once we have received ALL admissions materials and they have been reviewed, the applicant will be contacted to set up an appointment with Susan Griffin, the Nursing Program Coordinator, to discuss details about both Nursing and General Education course requirements specific to your academic record and needs. The review process takes 3-4 weeks. Applicants will be notified by mail once a decision has been made.



Relationship Based Care is a nursing model for transforming practice. It is a conceptual nursing model based on Caring theories and concepts and supports the three main relationships of
