Possible data elements (measures):

- Number of OCC students who transferred.
- Number of transfers from other institutions.
- Number of OCC students who completed their first term.
- Number of OCC students who returned for a second term (retention).
- First term GPA.
- Academic major at transfer institution.
- Social Security Number linked data.

If we are able to receive name linked data (SSN) we will then have the ability to match data which exists in our files. This will provide us with the opportunity to analyze data which will give us a better handle on the actual Transfer Effectiveness of OCC.
