### Some Trends

- •Migrations and new contracts in decline with economy
- •Adoption of next-generation interfaces, single search, Web 2.0 and mobile technology
- Companies are focusing on add-on products and services
- ERM (electronic resource management)
- Reexamining conceptual models of the ILS

# **New Concepts for New Systems**

- •URM from Ex Libris, a single system for management of all library resources
- •Kuali OLE (Open Library Environment), based on open source and open systems
- •OCLC Web Scale Services, cloud-based ILS, for general release in 2011/12

# **Open Source**

- •Made initial impression on the ILS market in 2006
- •By 2007, support companies LibLime and Equinox
- •No licensing; contracted installation, support, hosting
- Open source architecture for community development
- Making systems more "open" via APIs / web services

# **Open Source Notes**

- •As more libraries adopt open source ILS more libraries will sponsor development of the systems
- •Development will encourage commercial ILS vendors to adopt new features
- •As open source systems become full-featured there will more adoption by larger libraries and more types of libraries
- •More systems will become hosted and supported outside of the library
- •The library community generally supports the theory of open source and open systems for ILS

- •Built for large scale consortia, scalable ILS; next release to incorporate serials and acquisitions (September 2010)
- •Equinox formed to promote, support, develop the software; developers of Evergreen now with Equinox
- Conifer Project / Project Conifer <a href="http://projectconifer.ca/">http://projectconifer.ca/</a>

- •Acquired by a private equity firm in 2006, changing hands again in 2008, Ex Libris is the second largest ILS vendor; maintains largest staff

- •SFX Open URL resolver; also offers LinkFinder Plus, originally from Endeavor
- MetaLib federated search product
- Verde ERM
- •Introduced Open Platform Program in support of open systems; offering APIs
- •Caters to large academics, research libraries, and consortia
- Developing URM (Unified Resource Management) next-generation ILS
- •bX Recommender Service launched in 2009 2010

- •LibLime acquired by PTFS (Progressive Technology Federal Systems) in 2010, developed Enterprise Koha
- •Acquired CARE Affiliates in 2008; specialized in open-source repositories such as Fedora and Dspace 2010

- •Portfolio, digital access management and metadata harvester incorporating full-text searching
- •URSA resource sharing software supports NCIP
- •Working aggressively to develop APIs and web services; BookMyne iPhone App released in 2010

### **Next-Generation Interfaces**

- New public interface without migrating systems
- Focusing systems on the user interface and experience
- Integration of disparate collections

### **Next-Generation Characteristics**

- Decoupled interoperability
- Single search via compiled indexing separate from the ILS
- •Full-text searching of article level resources
- •Link resolver, built in
- •Relevancy ranking, spell checking and search suggestion, tagging, rating, reviews, faceted searching, RSS, SMS (text-messaging), enriched content







# The Future of the ILS Industry
