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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Methodology

Three versions of the Hospitality Industry Poll were administered – Culinary Arts, Restaurant Management and Hotel/Motel Management. Telephone surveys were conducted among people currently employed in the industry. The Culinary Arts survey was to be administered to caterers, chefs, and cooks who worked in restaurants, hotel restaurants, public golf course restaurants, and catering services. The Hotel/Motel Management survey was conducted among managers of hotels and motels (including ski resorts, and lodges). The Restaurant Management survey was administered to restaurant managers from various dining establishments, including restaurants at hotels, motels, and public golf courses.

A total of 351 surveys were completed. The sample distribution by type of survey and by industry is as follows:

Limitations

When contacting restaurants, two versions of the survey were administered to the same establishment -- the manager completed the Restaurant Management survey and the head chef/cook completed the Culinary Arts Survey. However, in some cases, the restaurant manager or owner was also the head chef. In those instances, the same person completed both the Culinary Arts and Restaurant Management survey.

Additionally, there were instances when the head cook did not speak English and/or when the restaurant manager would not allow the cook to complete an interview. In several of those instances, the manager and/or owner completed the Culinary Arts survey. Therefore, the distribution of the 140 Culinary Arts respondents is as follows:

- Cooks/Chefs, Assistant Cooks/Chefs, Executive Chefs, Kitchen Managers 88
- Owners 24
- Managers/General Managers/Assistant Managers, Vice President, etc. 13
- Manager/Cook or Manager/Chef 11
- Owner/Chef 4

Key Findings

- For all three types of surveys combined, OCC had the highest *top-of-mind* awareness¹, with 23.1% of all respondents mentioning OCC first when asked about the schools that offered education and training in hospitality.
 - For Culinary Arts specifically, top-of-mind awareness for OCC (30.7%) was virtually the same as the top-of-mind awareness for Schoolcraft (30.0%).
 - For Hotel/Motel Management, Michigan State University had the highest topof-mind awareness (19.6%), followed by OCC (12.7%).
 - For Restaurant Management, OCC's top-of-mind awareness was 23.1%, followed by Schoolcraft (16.7%) and Michigan State (15.7%).
- OCC had the highest overall total unaided awareness² (40.3%). Specifically, OCC had the highest total unaided awareness for Culinary Arts (56.4%) and Restaurant Management (36.1%).

¹ Top-of-Mind Awareness: A percentage based upon the number of times that a particular school was the *first* school mentioned when respondents were asked which local colleges or schools offer education specific to a particular program.

particular program. ² Total Unaided Awareness: The percentage of respondents that mentioned a particular school (regardless of the order mentioned) when asked which local colleges or schools offer education specific to a particular program.

³ Aided Awareness: Based upon the number of respondents that did not initially mention OCC when asked which local colleges or schools offered a program, but indicated that they were actually aware of OCC's program when directly asked if they knew that OCC offered courses in that field.

- Total awareness (aided and unaided awareness combined) was highest for OCC's Culinary Arts program, with 72.1% of respondents aware that OCC has a Culinary Arts (and/or Baking and Pastry) program. Total awareness for the Hotel/Motel Management and Restaurant Management programs were 35.3% and 51.4% respectively.
- Although awareness was highest for OCC, when asked which school had the highest quality program, Schoolcraft College and Michigan State out-ranked Oakland Community College. More than half (57.5%) of respondents answering the question felt that Schoolcraft had the highest quality Culinary Arts program and 44.7% felt that Michigan State had the best Hotel/Motel Management program. Both Schoolcraft and Michigan State led OCC in Restaurant Management.

- When asked why they believed that Schoolcraft had the highest quality Culinary Arts program, several interviewees cited the Schoolcraft's reputation and awards received, positive experiences with the graduates of the program, and the fact that it has Master Chefs on staff.
- Several respondents felt that Michigan State's Hotel/Motel Management program was the best because of its reputation as a high quality, nationally/world renowned program, and because of positive experiences with graduates. Of those who felt that Michigan State had the best Restaurant Management program, a few also mentioned the student-operated hotel, banquet center and restaurant used to train students.
