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Introduction

Purpose of the Study

The purpose of this study is to gauge the public's general awareness and perceptions of Oakland Community College's Hospitality program, as well as other area collegiate hospitality programs. OCC's Hospitality department is initiating a new marketing campaign. The findings of this report will provide a baseline of information about the public's view of the current program. In addition, this study will be administered in one year to gain an understanding of changes in the general public's awareness and image of OCC's Hospitality Program.

Methodology

A stratified sample of 12,000 people between the ages of 18 and 50 was obtained from Practical Political Consulting, using the following geographic criteria:

✓ The sample includes all of Oakland County <u>excluding</u> the northeast, north central and northwest portions of Oakland County and also includes the eastern section of Livingston County.

Of this sample, Institutional Research compiled 518 completed surveys. The data analyzed within this report is based <u>only</u> on completed surveys from 215 respondents between the ages of 18 and 50. It was deemed necessary to use only these respondents as the Program Marketing team has identified their target market as individuals between 18 and 50. A copy of the survey in its entirety can be found in Appendix A. This document illustrates the skip patterns involved based upon respondents' answers.

Key Findings

- Most survey respondents were Caucasian (90%) and female (78%). In addition, 55% of respondents were between 40 and 49 years of age.
- ➤ Roughly two-thirds of respondents cited they had watched HGTV (67%) or read the Food section of the newspaper (60%) within the last 30 days.
- > Schoolcraft is the culinary school most mentioned by respondents with nearly 40% of respondents citing this as a college they are aware of that offers culinary arts. Oakland Community College (OCC) followed with almost 30% of respondents naming OCC.
- > Seventy-three percent (n=22) of all respondents citing Schoolcraft as the school with the highest quality culinary programs were 40 to 50 years old.
- ➤ The most frequent reply by respondents who were asked which school offers hotel/motel/restaurant management programs was "don't know" (37%).

 Michigan State University (MSU) was the school most cited by the respondents (25%).
- Slightly over half (52%) of 40 to 50 year olds cited MSU <u>first</u> as a college with a hotel/motel/restaurant management program.
- Of those who did <u>not</u> cite OCC as a school with a culinary program of which they are aware, eighty-six percent of these same respondents did not know that OCC offers courses in the culinary arts and baking fields. Further, of these respondents, 20% live in southwest Oakland County and 19% in southeast Oakland County.
- ➤ Similarly, ninety percent of those polled (who didn't mention OCC previously) were unaware that OCC has a program in hotel/motel and restaurant management. In addition, many of these respondents reside in southeast (24%) and central eastern (17%) Oakland County.

Key Findings (cont.)

- ➤ Those respondents stating they were aware of OCC's culinary or hotel/motel/restaurant management programs were asked to rate OCC in four areas compared to other college programs they named. It is important to note that the samples sizes for these questions are relatively small, as noted.
 - 89% rated <u>OCC's reputation</u> as slightly above average (67%) or far above average (22%). (N=27)
 - 87% rated the <u>quality of OCC's faculty</u> as slightly above average (65%) or far above average (22%) (N=23)
 - Sixty-four percent said they thought the <u>quality of OCC's programs</u> was slightly above average, while 20% said the quality was far above average. (N=25)
 - o People ranked the <u>reputation of OCC's hospitality program</u> as slightly above average (72.2%) and far above average (16.7%). (N=18)
