ESL Credit Hour Trends Analysis

Executive Summary

At the request of the English as a Second Language (ESL) department, Institutional Research (IR) prepared the following analysis of enrollment (credit hours) trends for the discipline over the time period 1999-2000 through 2003-2004. The purpose of the study was to answer the following research questions:

- To what extent has enrollment in ESL courses changed over the past five years, by course and campus?
- How have foreign student status categories changed over the past five years by campus?
- To what extent are these trends similar to and different from those at other southeast Michigan community colleges and universities?
- How has the ESL curriculum changed over the past five years?

This particular analysis will address the first two questions itemized above. For the purposes of this study, end of session student information system data files were used. The following highlights key findings of this analysis:

- Overall, student credit hours have increased sharply and then decreased over the past five years. The lowest reported credit hours over the past five years was the 9,689 reported in 1999-00 and the high of 14,749 reported in 2001-02. The current 11,711 reported credit hours for 2003-04 represents a 20.6% decline from the peak reported in 2001-02.
- Five-year trends by campus are varied as well. Tammy you'll need to update/change these to reflect new figures.
 - The Orchard Ridge campus has the most ESL students taking courses at their campus. Orchard Ridge peaked in 2001-02 (6,163) and decreased by 24% from 2001-02 to 2003-04 (4,968).
 - Auburn Hills credit hours have remained somewhat steady over the same time period: 2001-02 (3,765) to 2003-04 (3,393).
 - The Southfield campus credit hours have fluctuated sharply with a high overall enrollment of 3,072 in 2001-02, to 534 in 2003-04.
- Immigration status information is only available for the 2002-03 and 2003-04 academic years.

- The largest decrease in immigration status for the two academic years was for Non-residents. Declining from 101 student headcount in 2002-03 to 55 in 2003-04. *vtm 3/1/04*
- The largest increases in immigration status were in the Permanent Resident Alien category and Non-resident Alien categories. Permanent Resident student headcount increased from 592 students in 2002-03 to 842 students in 2003-04. (Resident Alien student headcount increased from 6 students in 2002-03 to 31 students in 2003-04.)

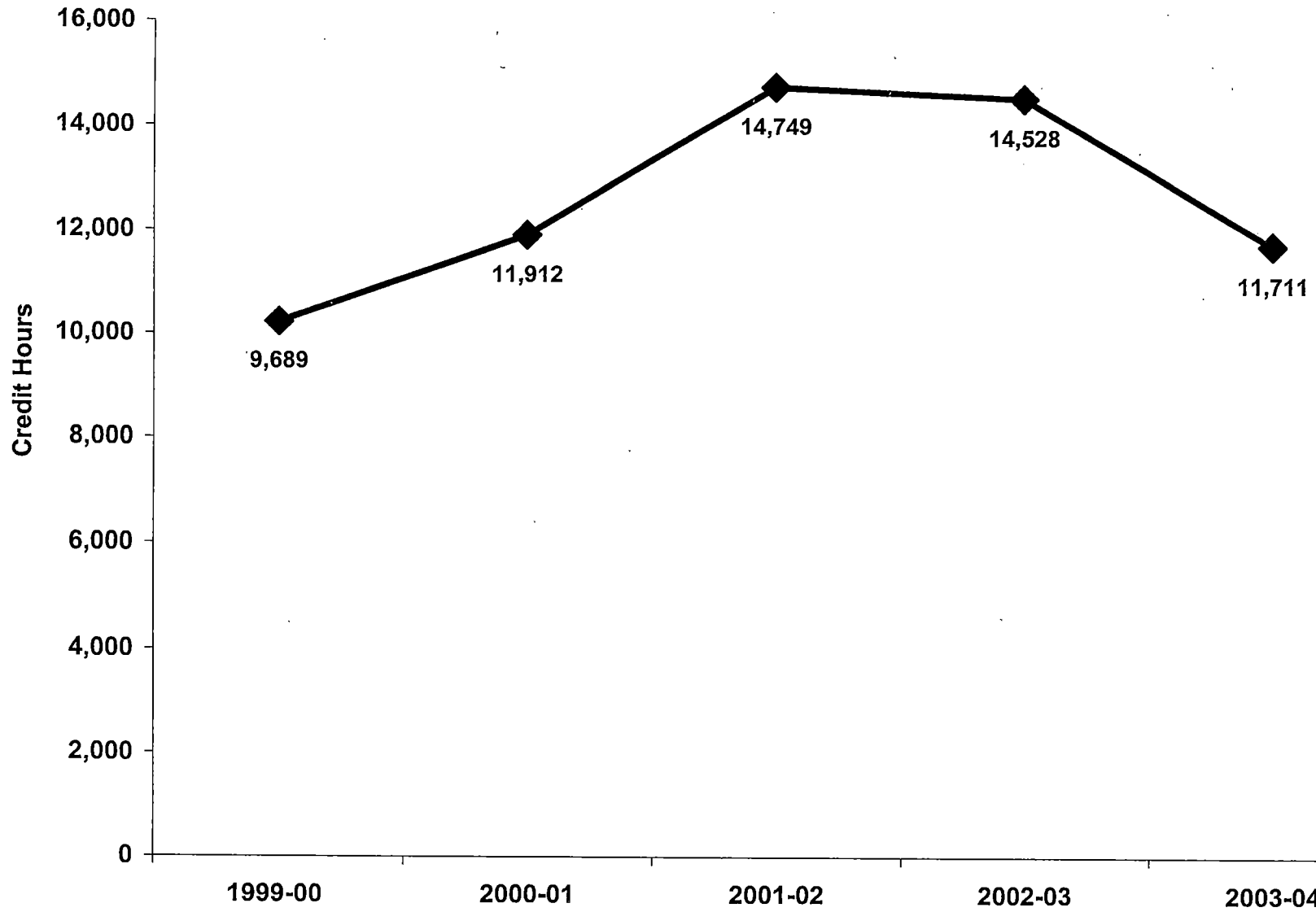

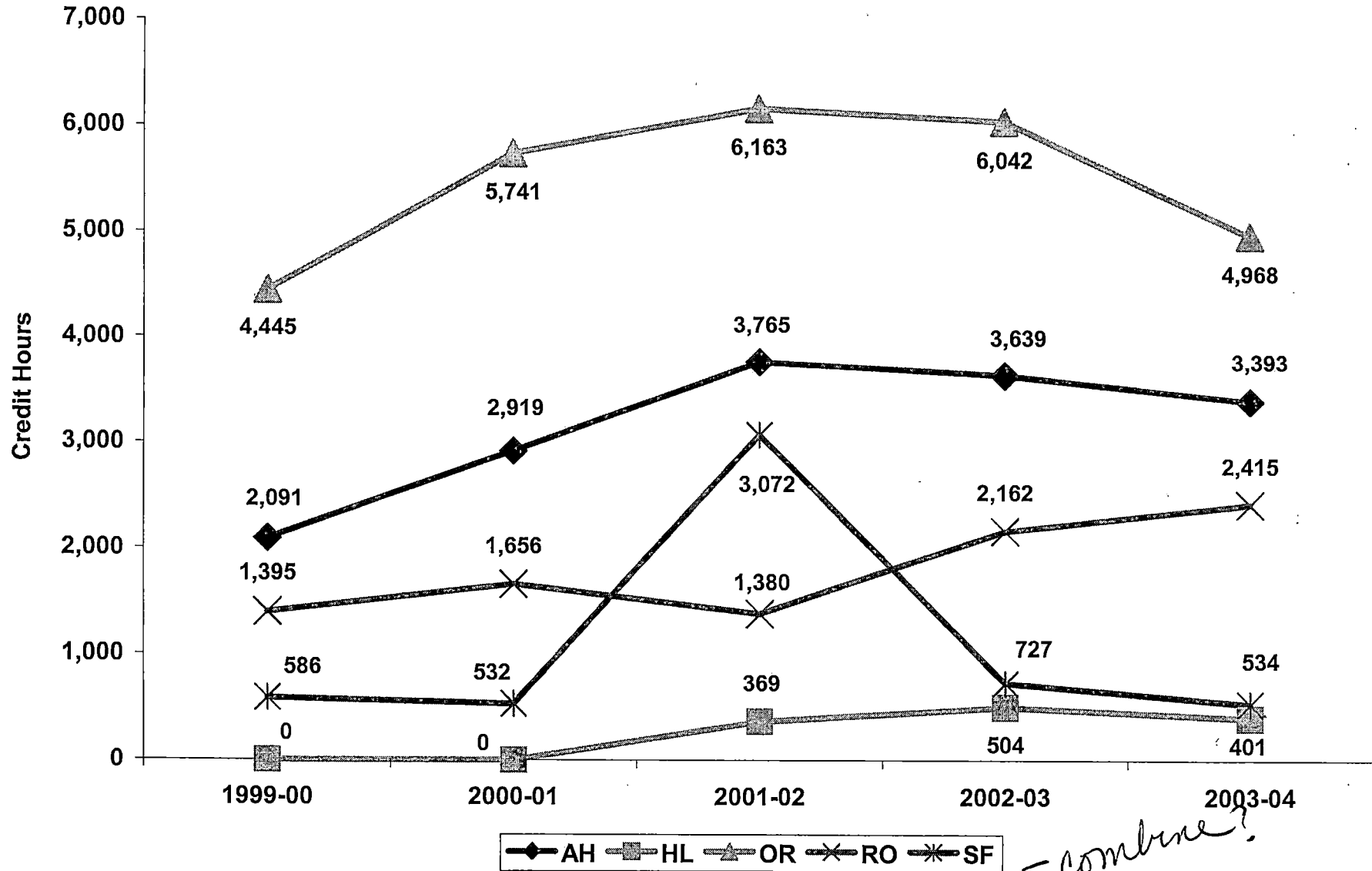

ESL Credit Hours College Wide 1999-2004



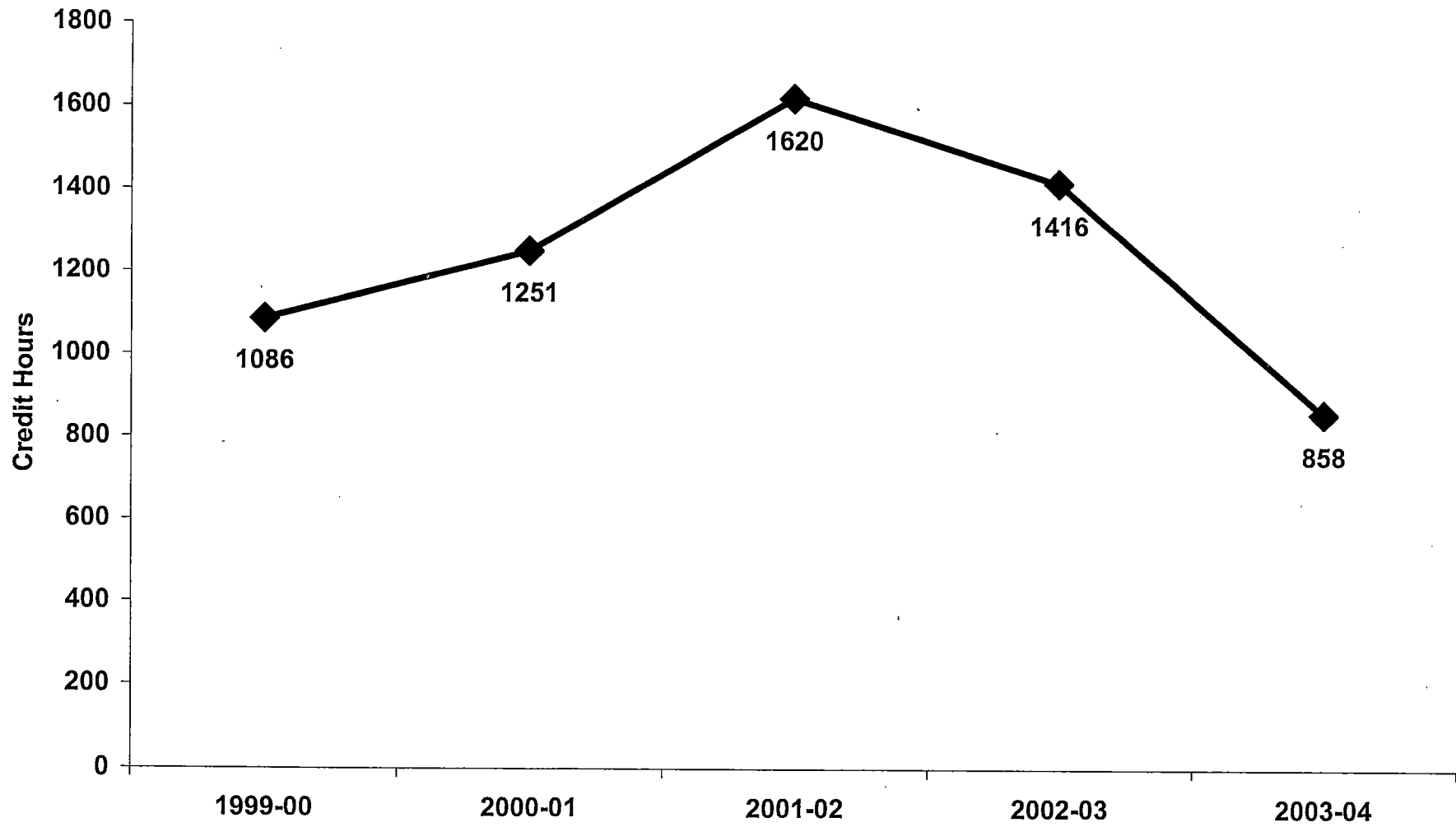

Total ESL Credit Hours by Campus 1999-2004



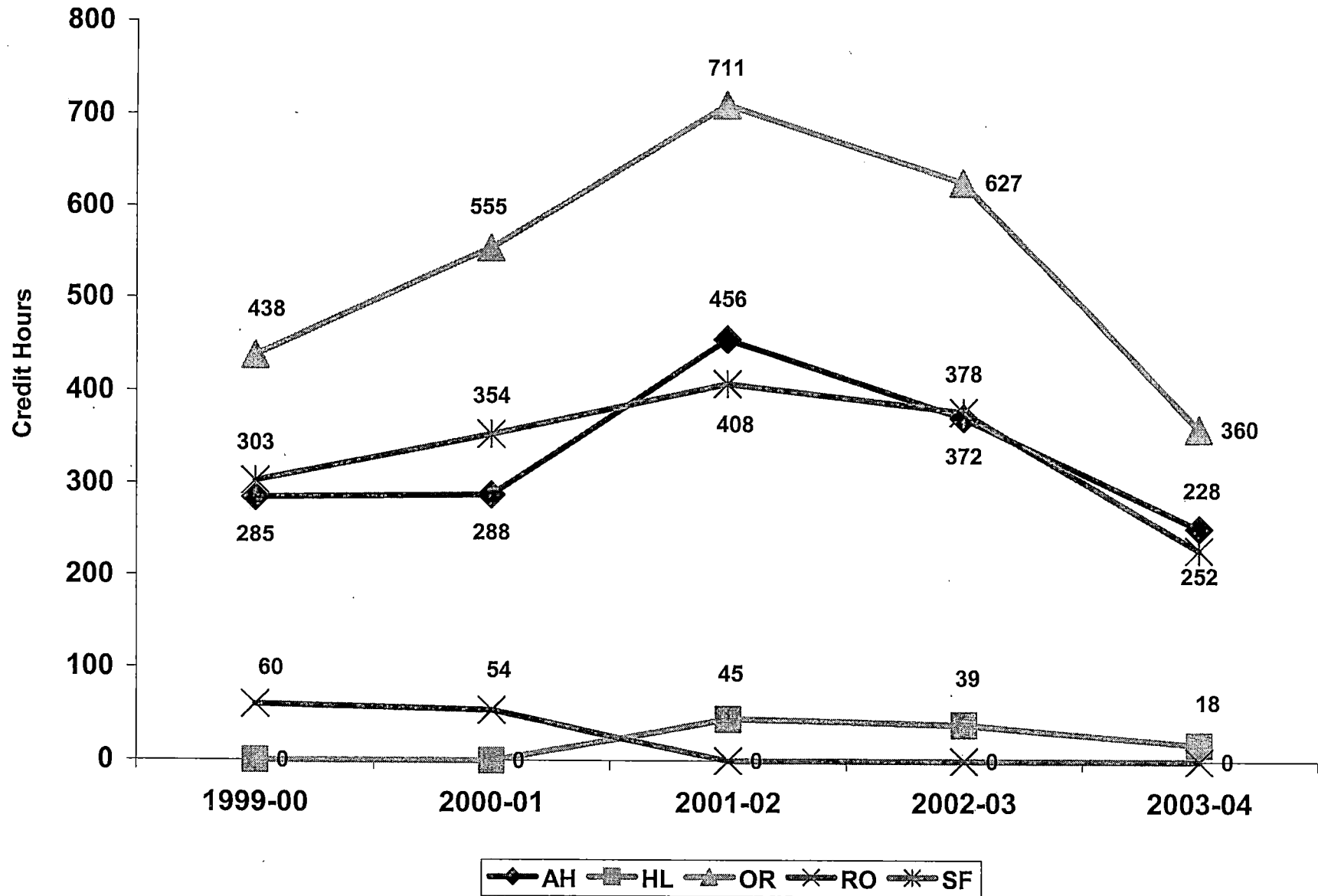

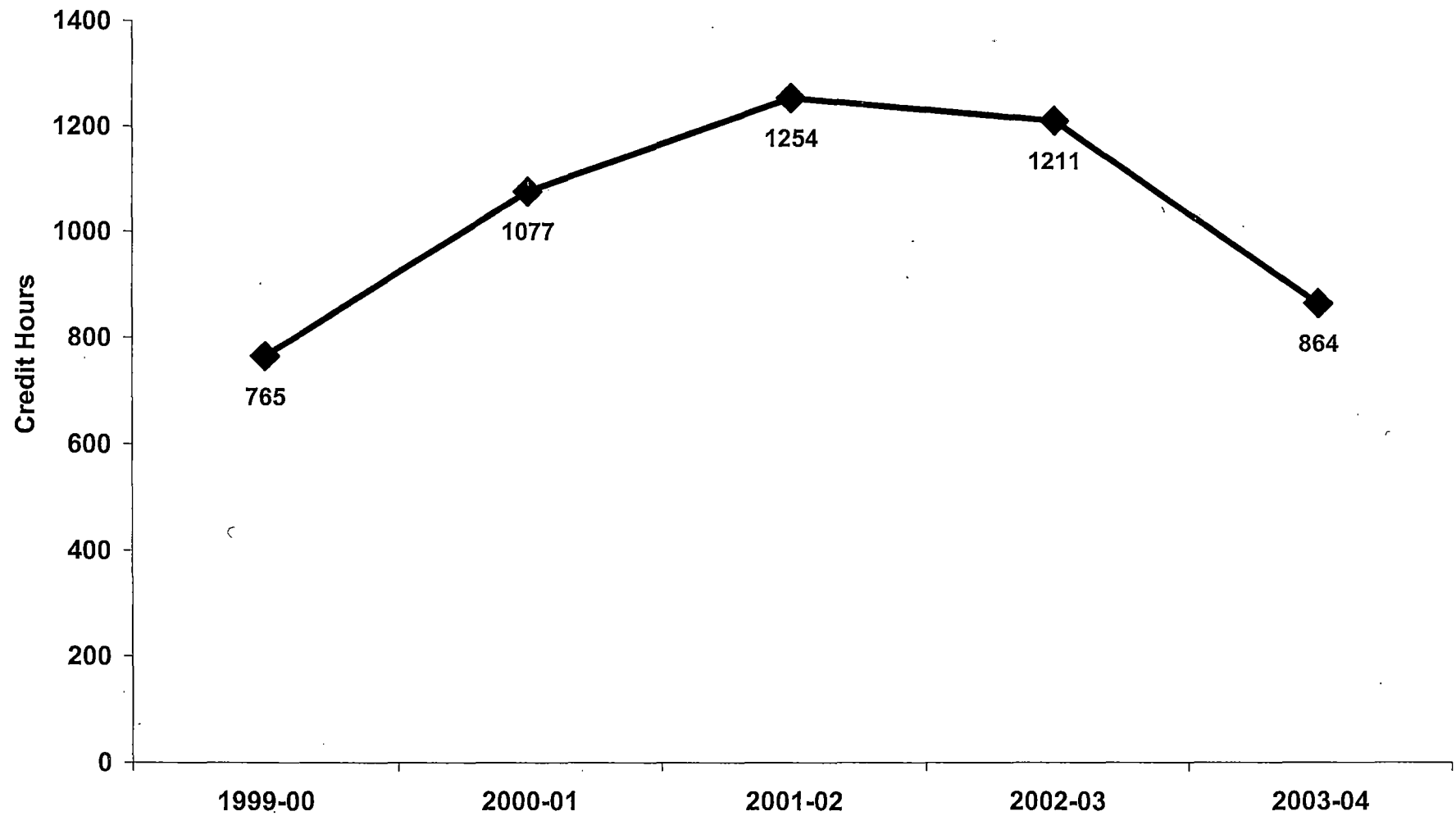

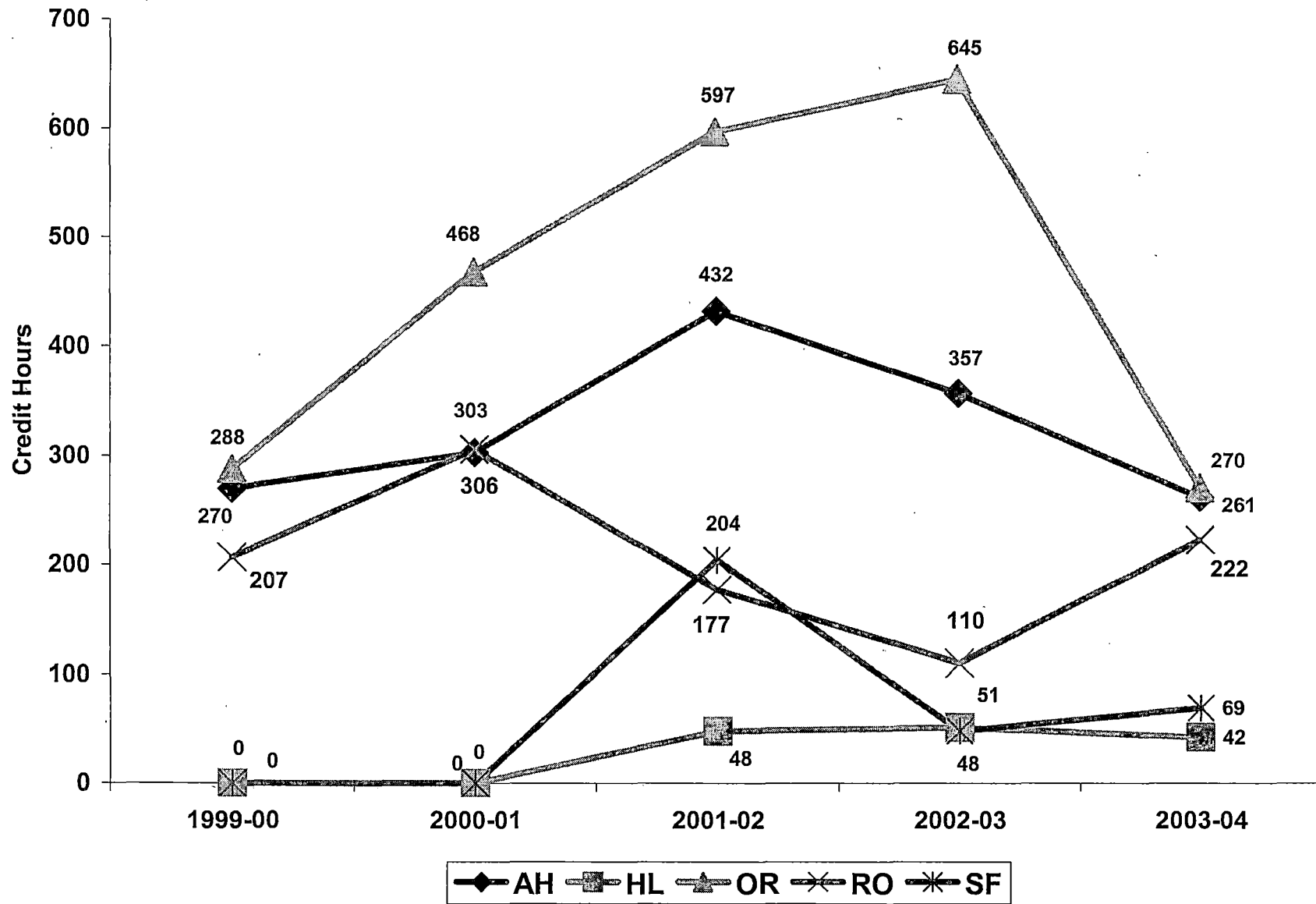
ESL Credit Hours by Course ESL 1010



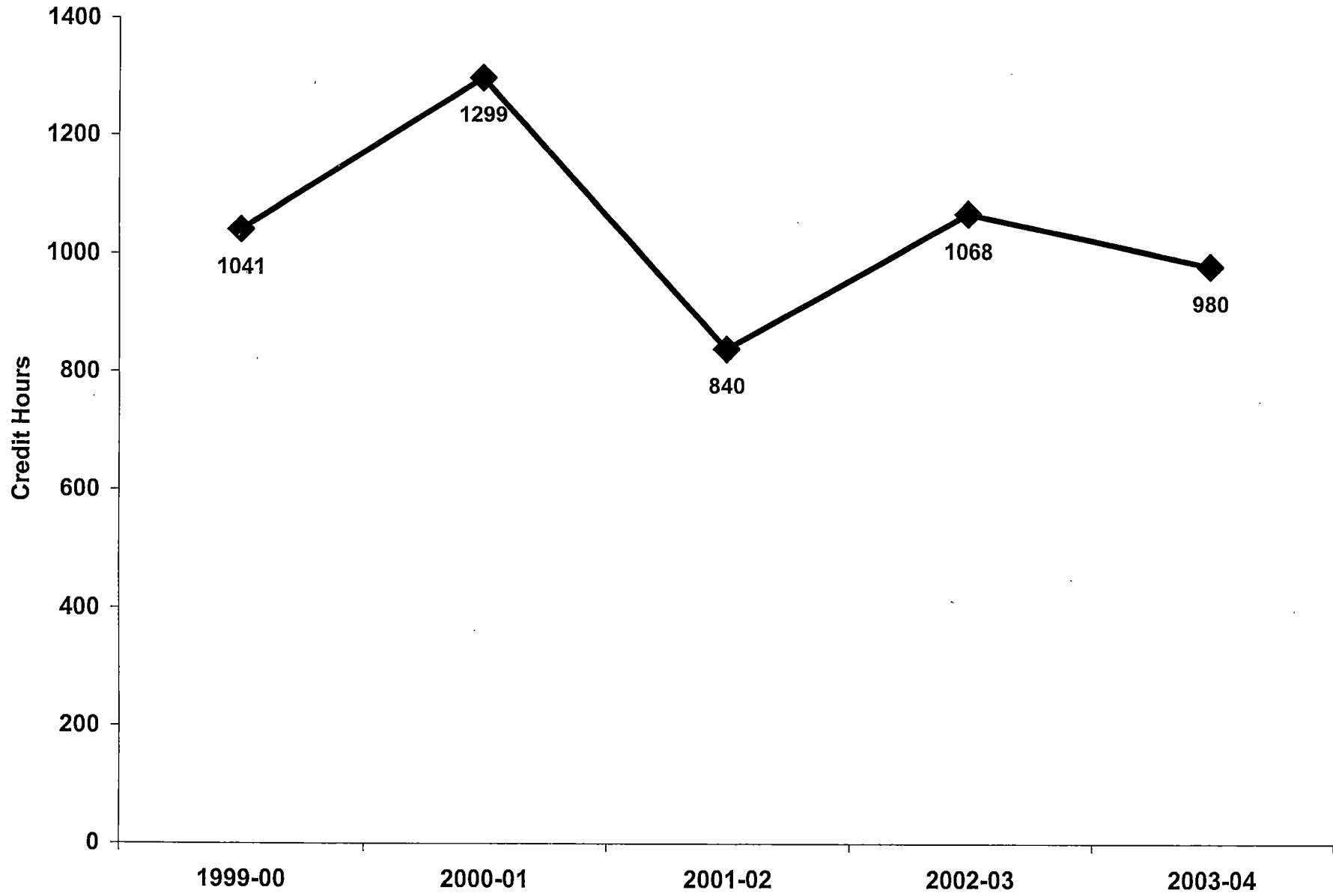

ESL Credit Hours by Course ESL 1020

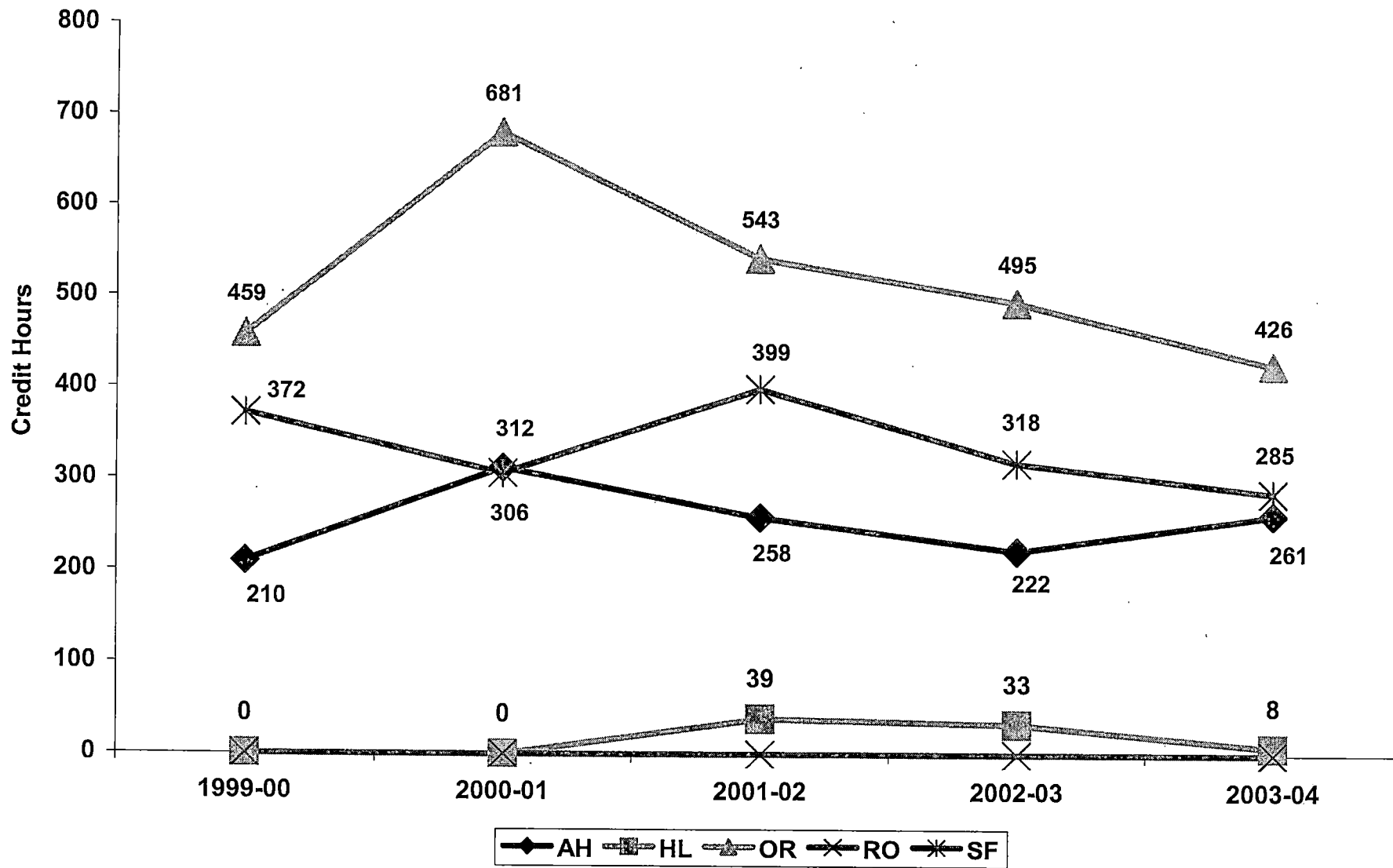

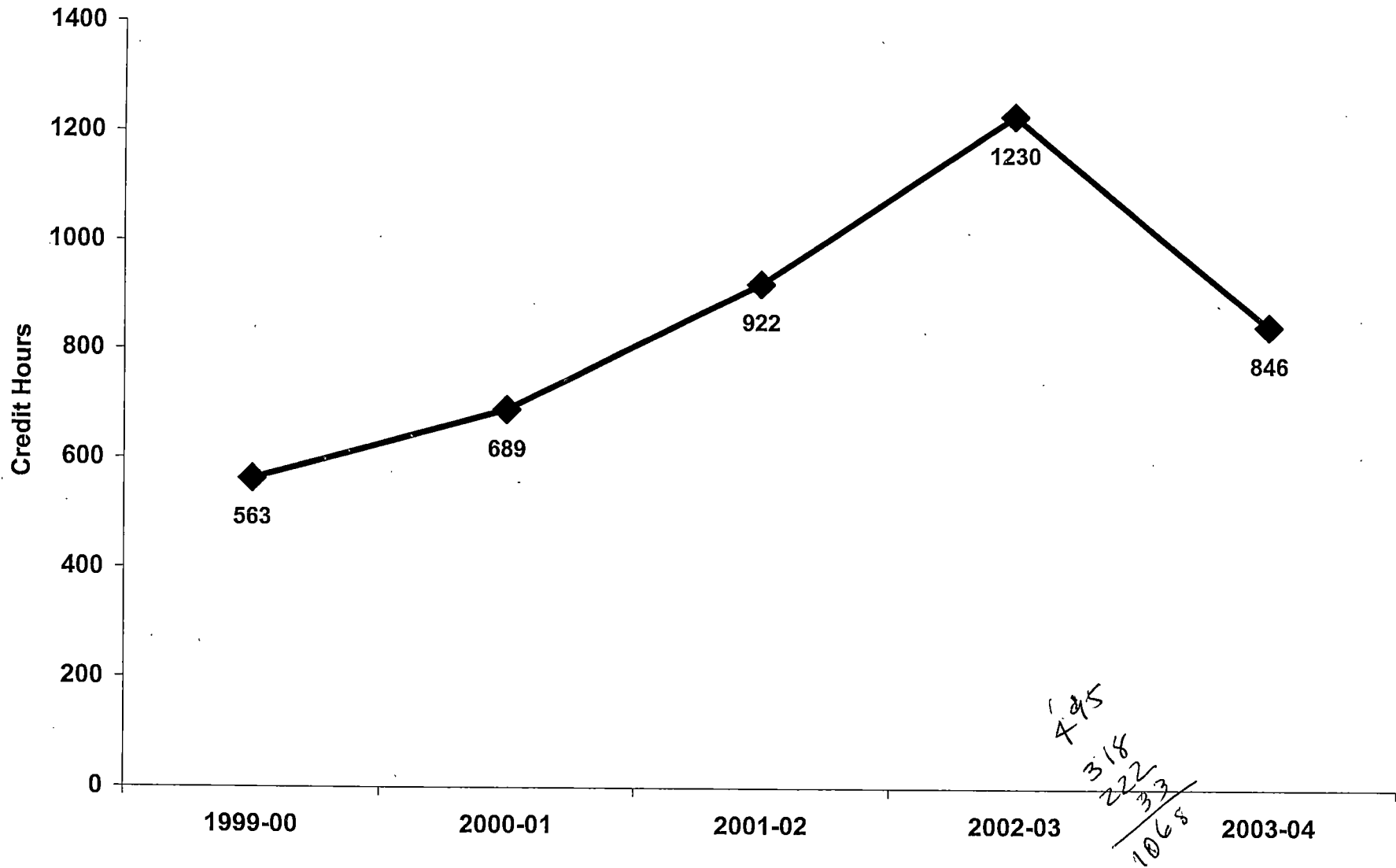

ESL Credit Hours by Course ESL 1410

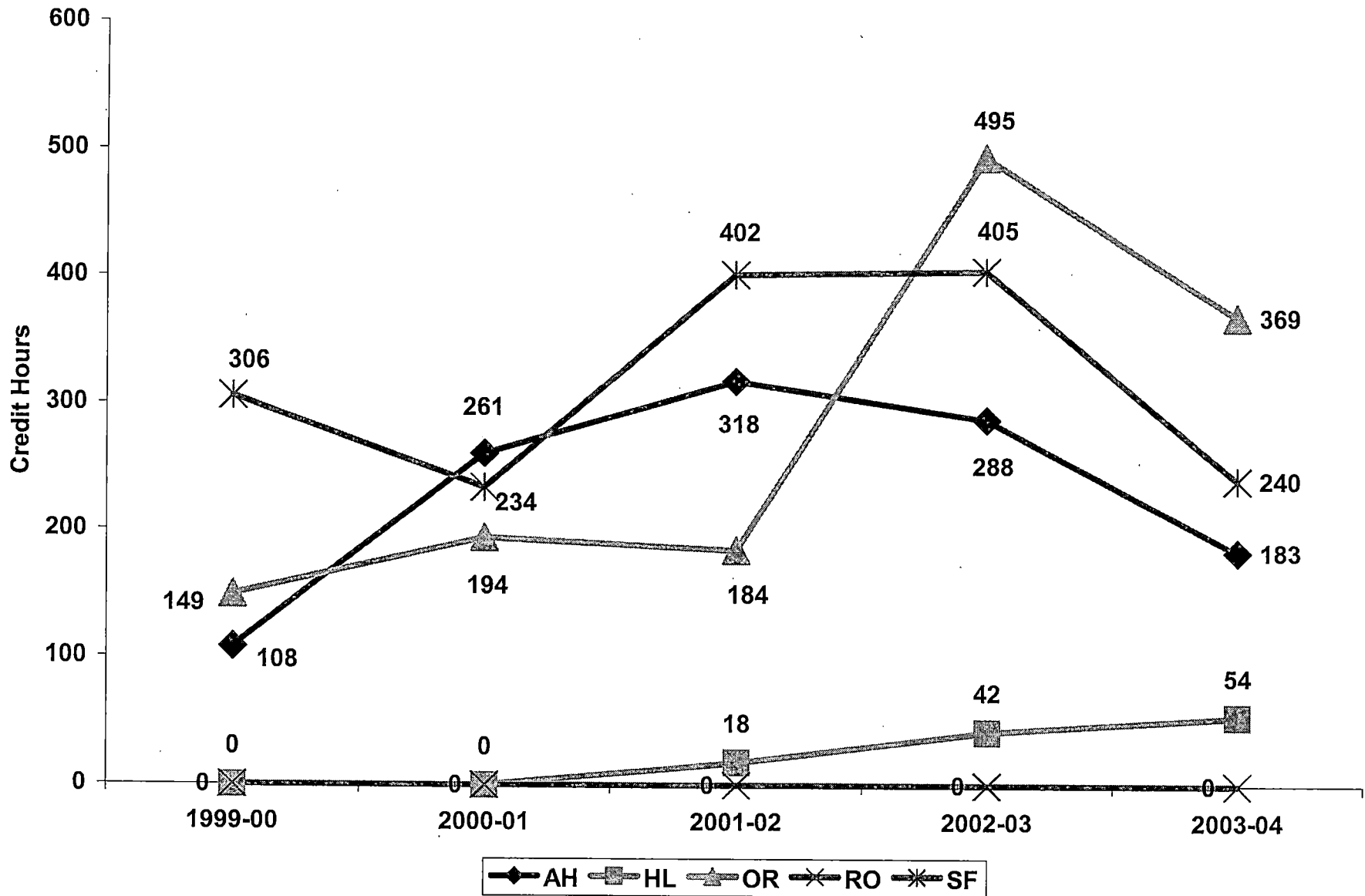

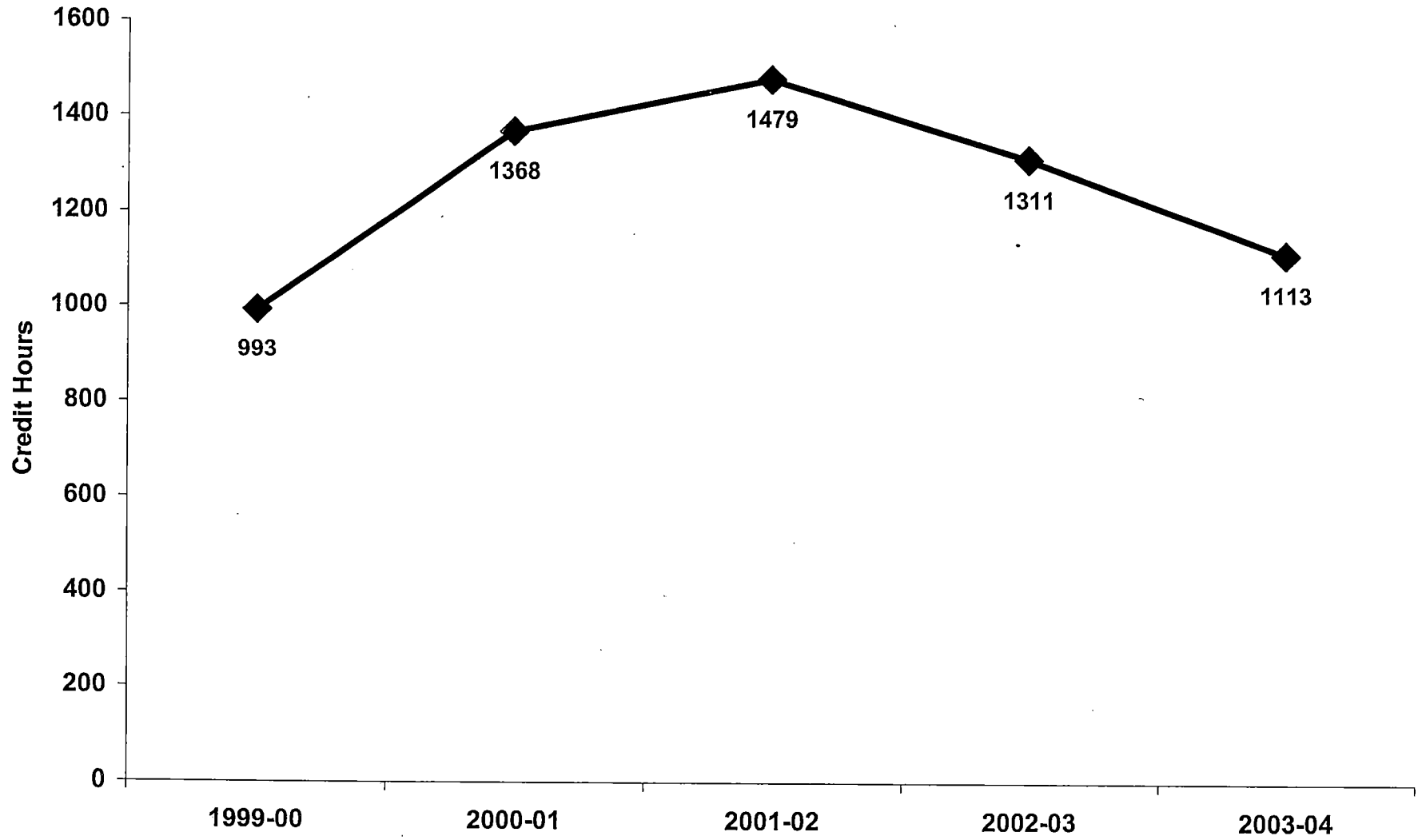


ESL Credit Hours by Course ESL 1420



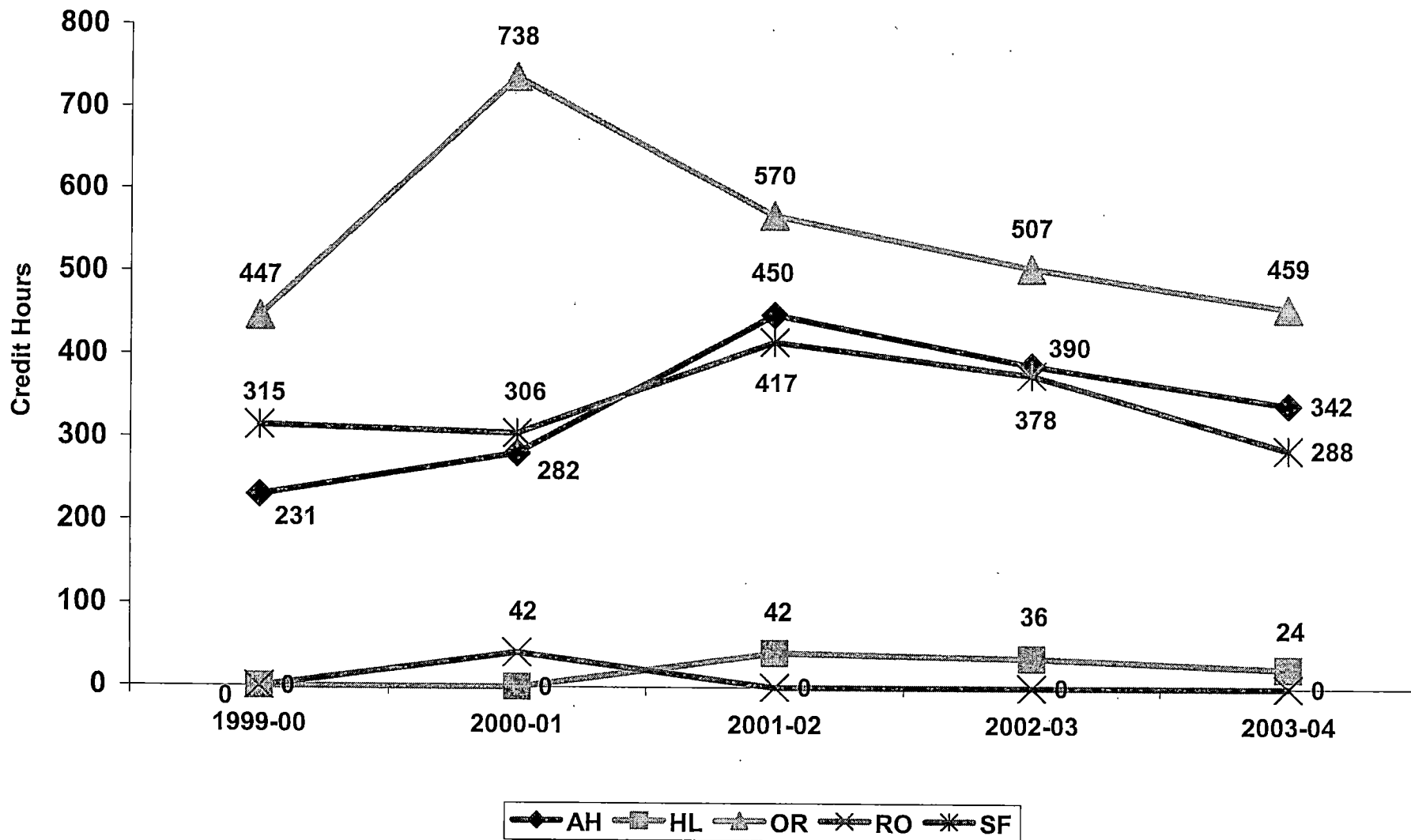

ESL 1510 College Wide

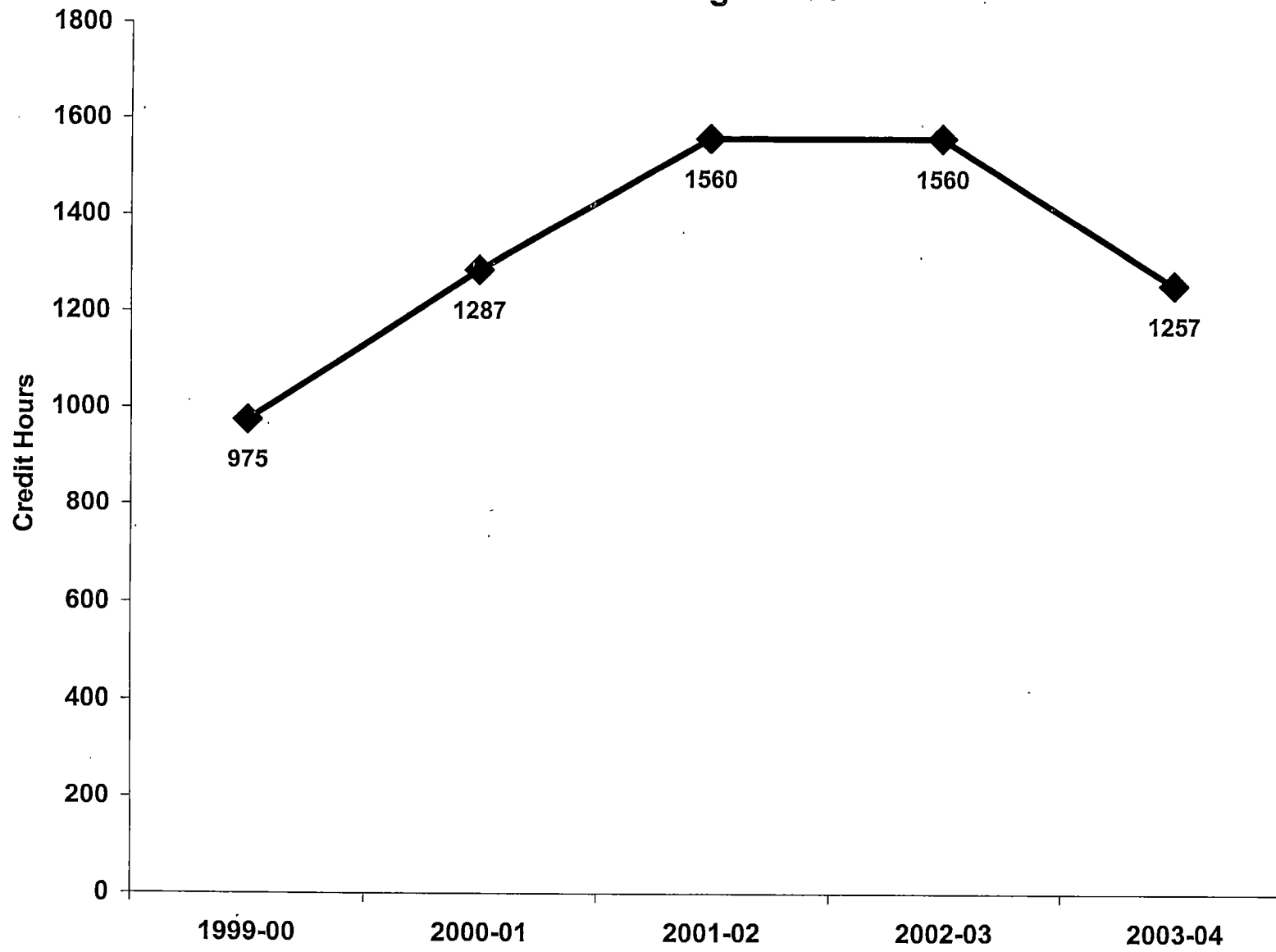

ESL Credit Hour Trends by Course ESL 1510

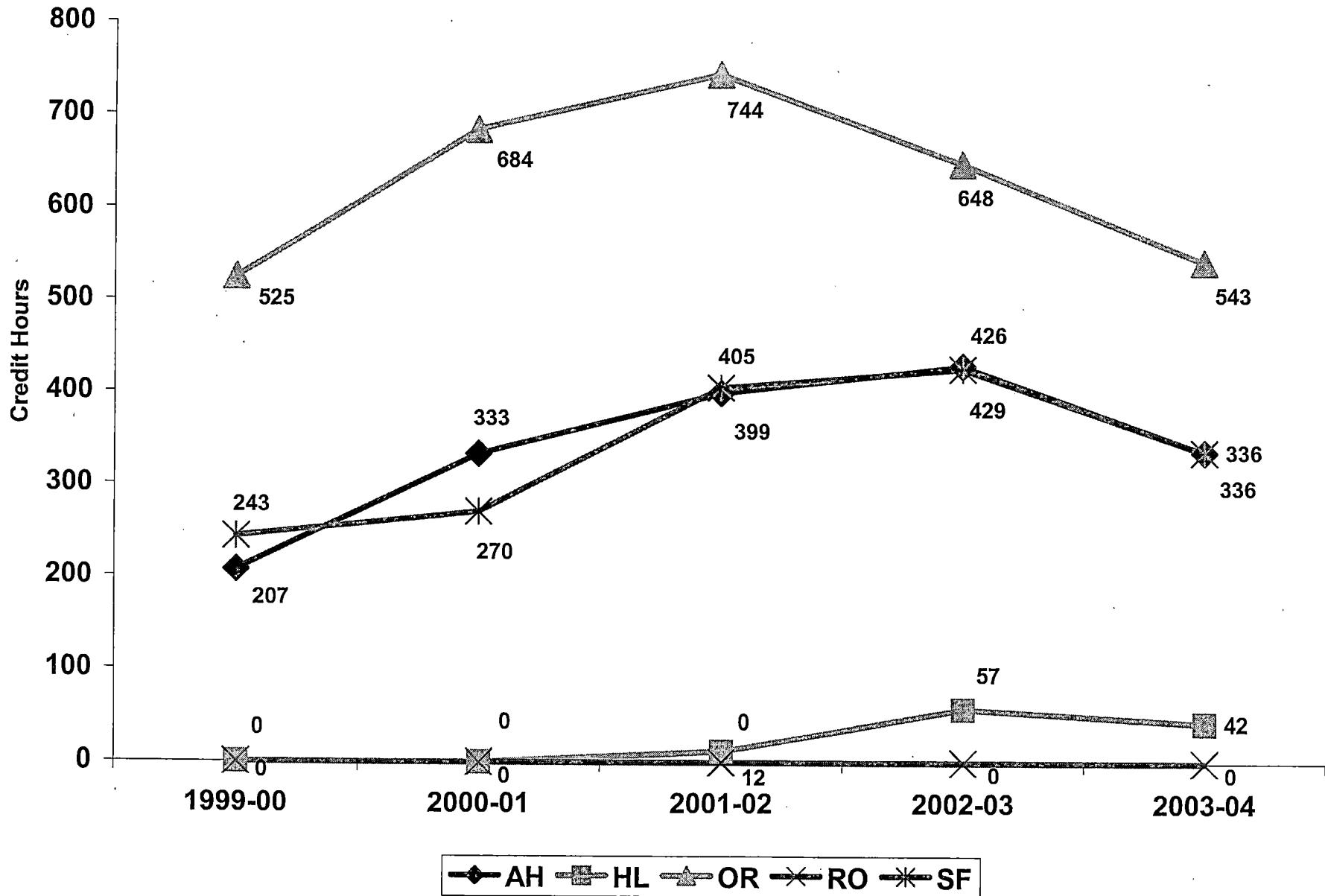

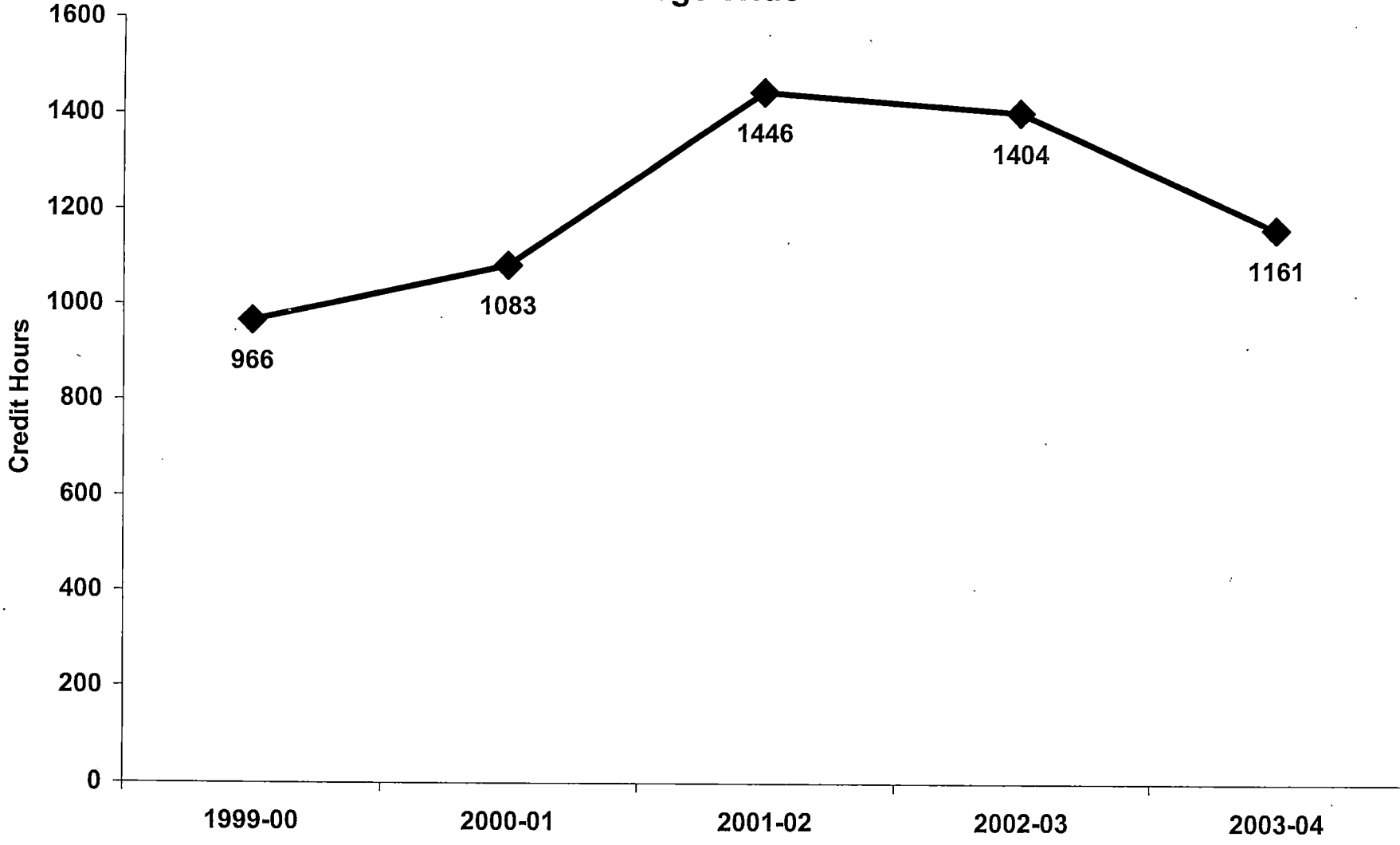

ESL Credit Hours by Course ESL 1520



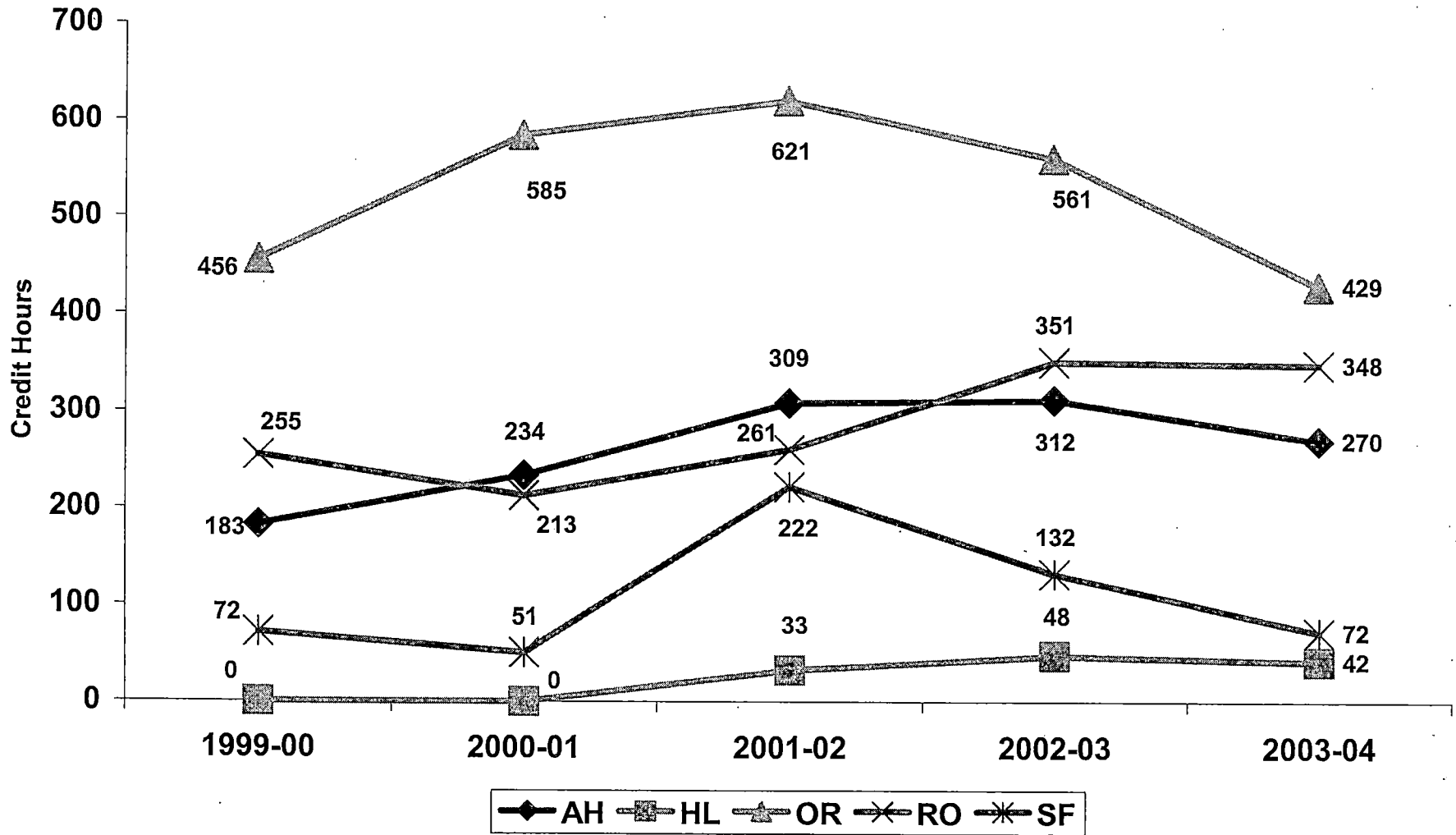

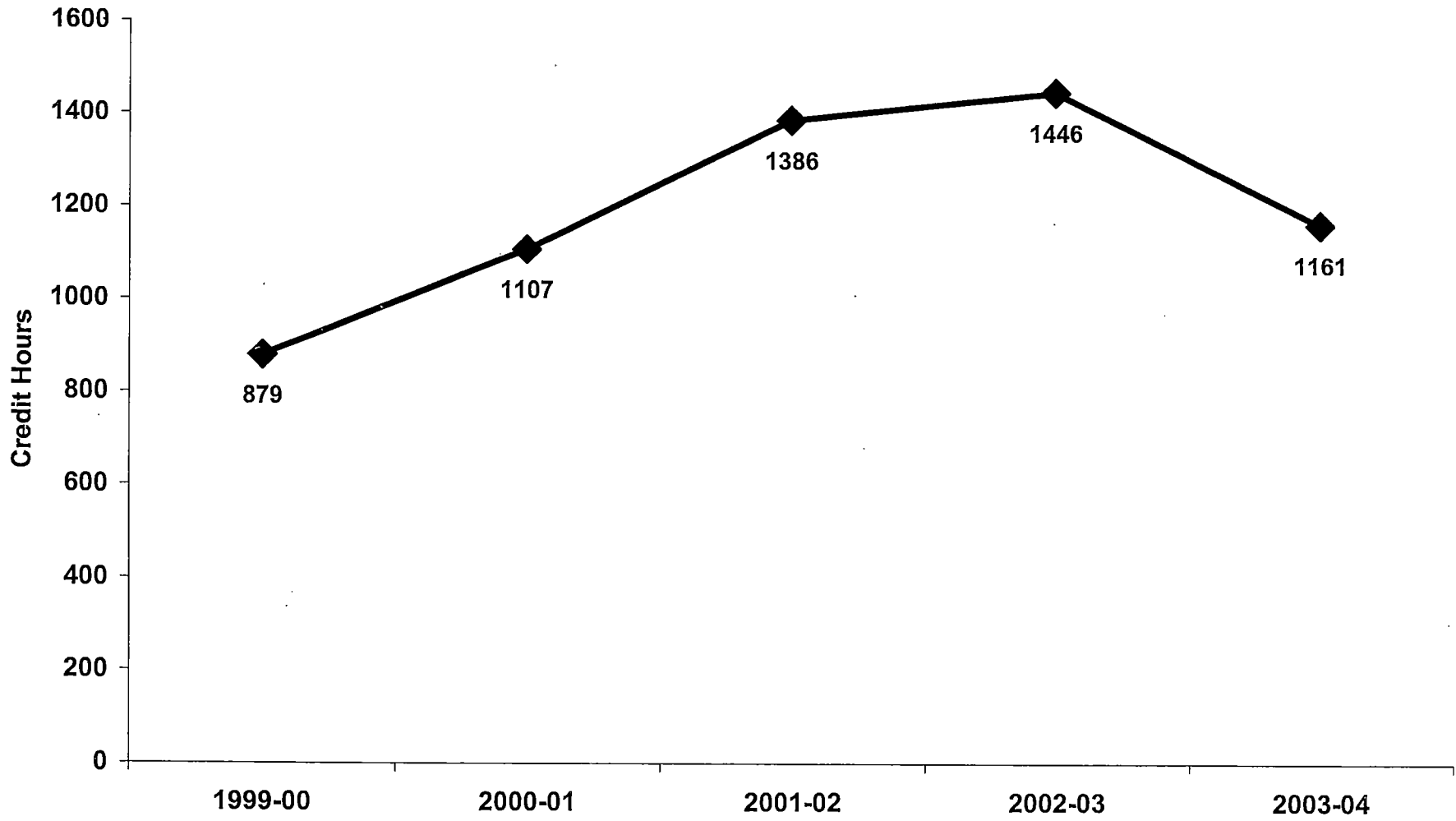

ESL Credit Hours by Course ESL 2410

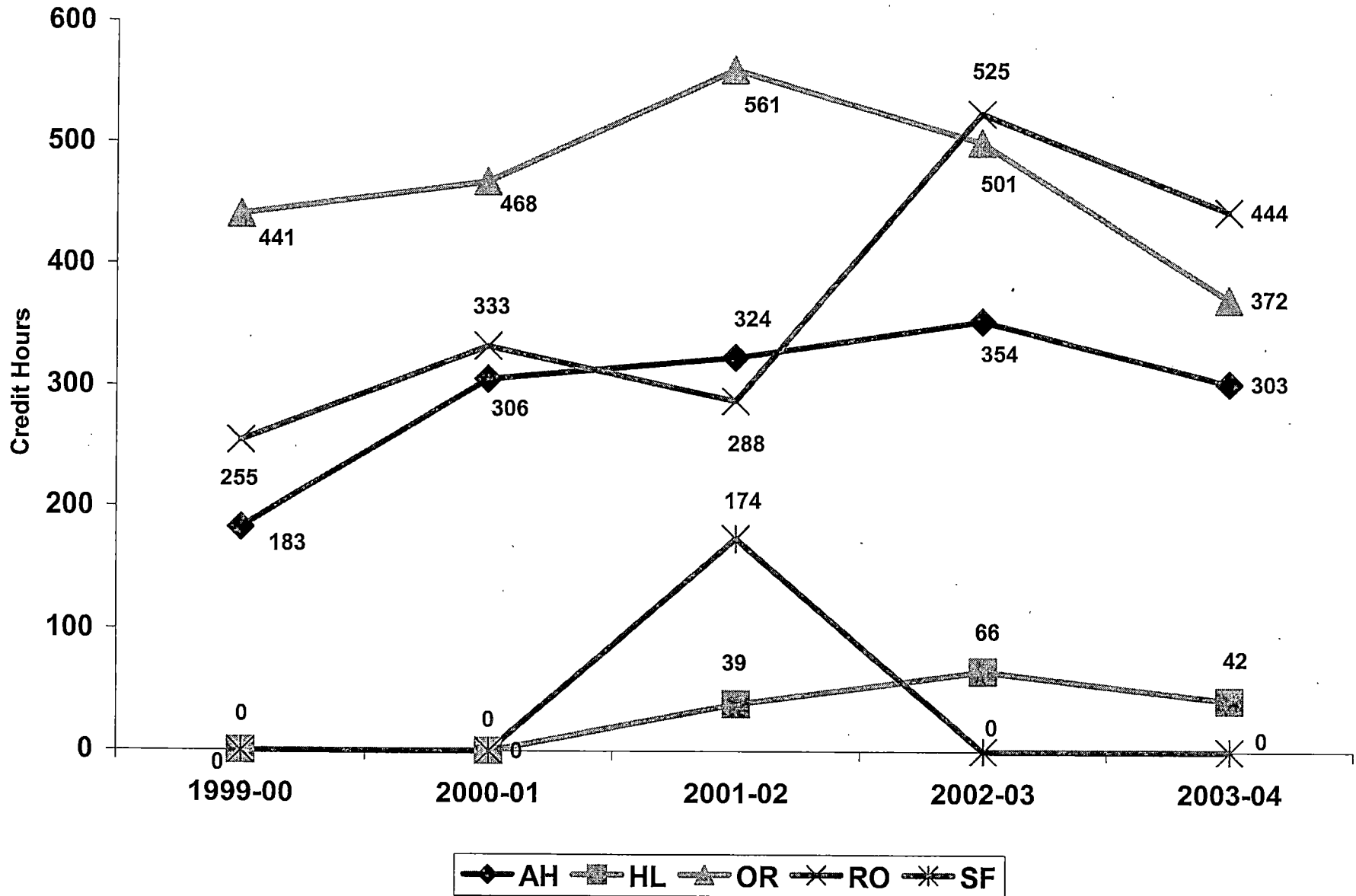

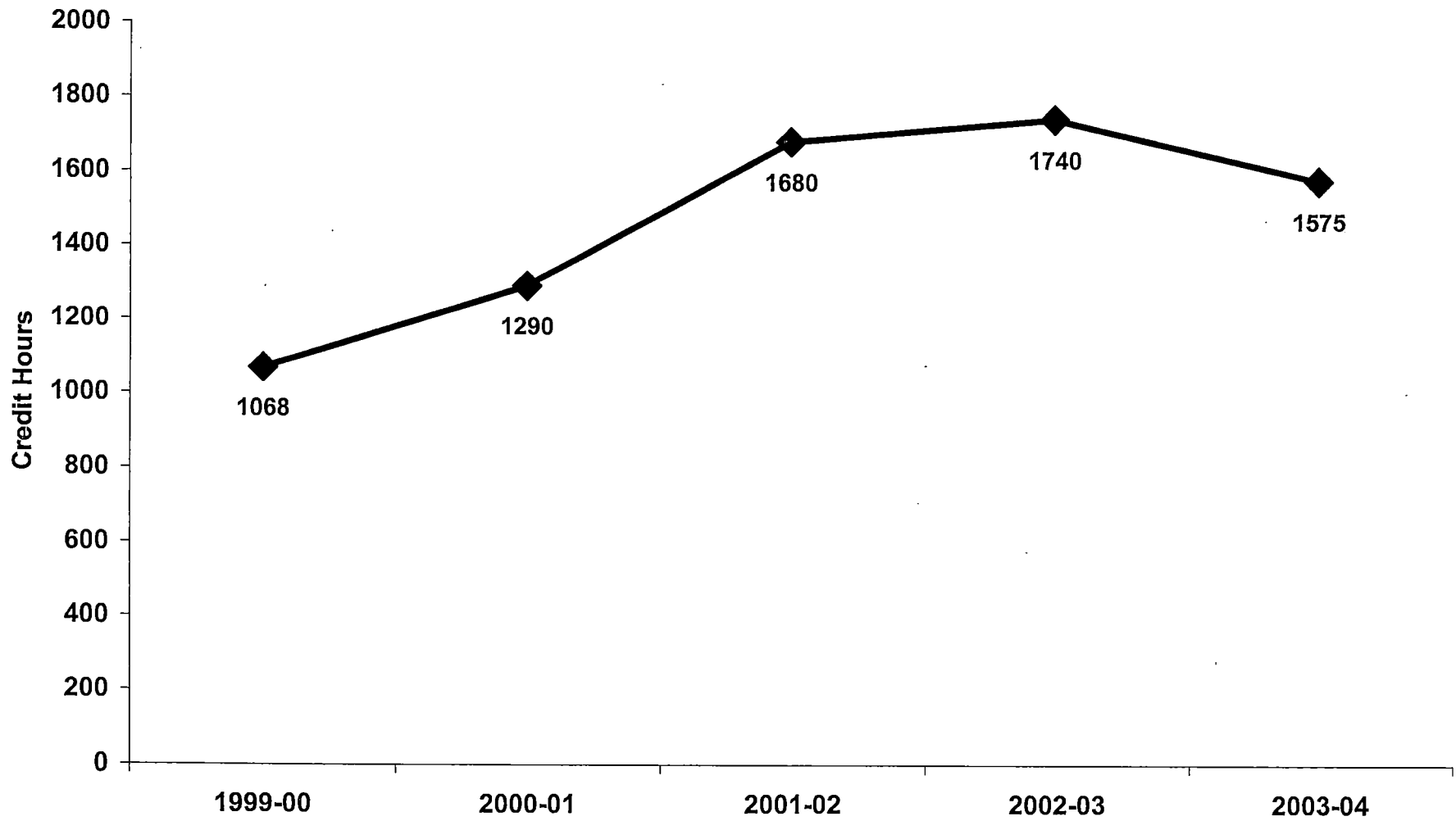

ESL Credit Hours by Course ESL 2420

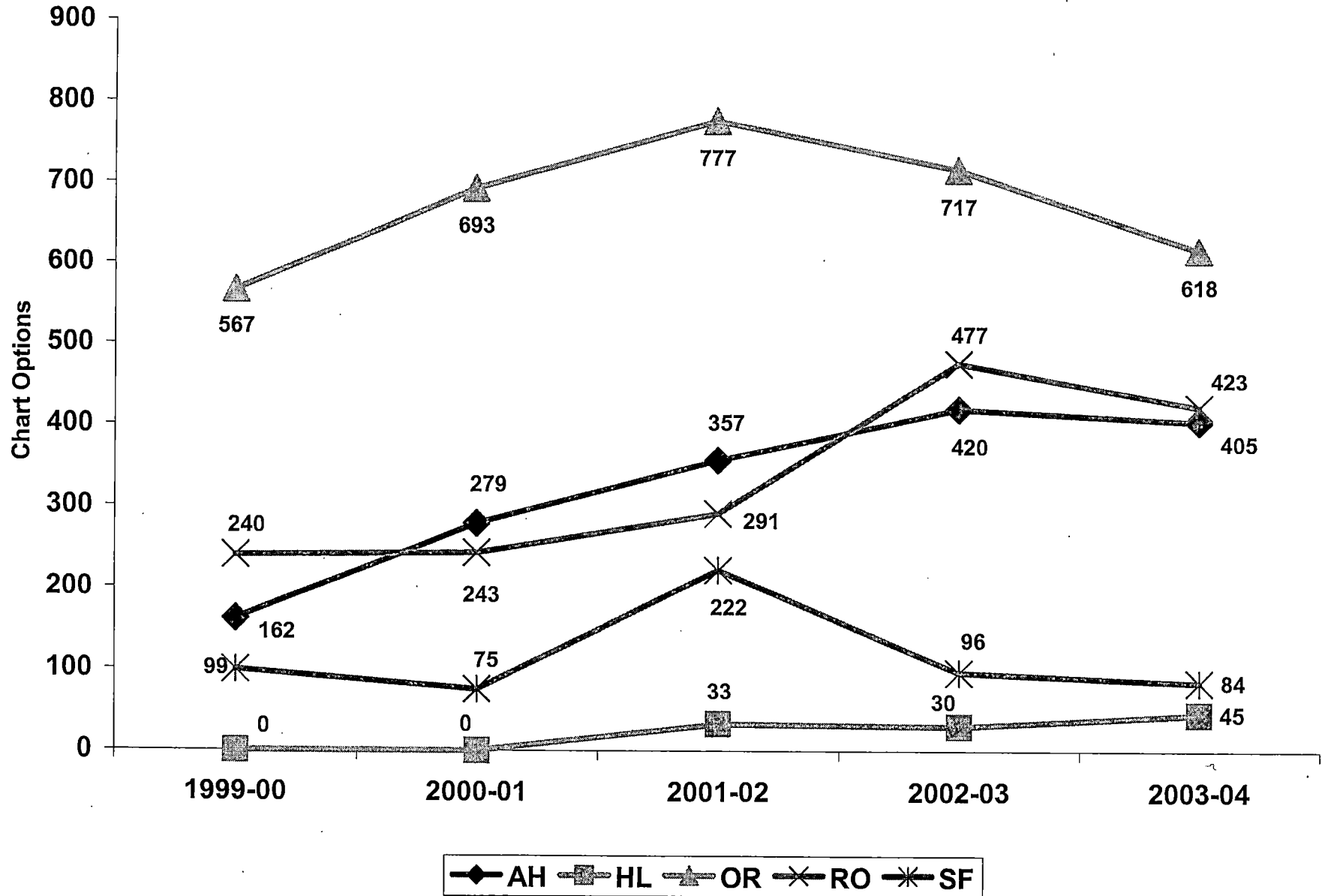

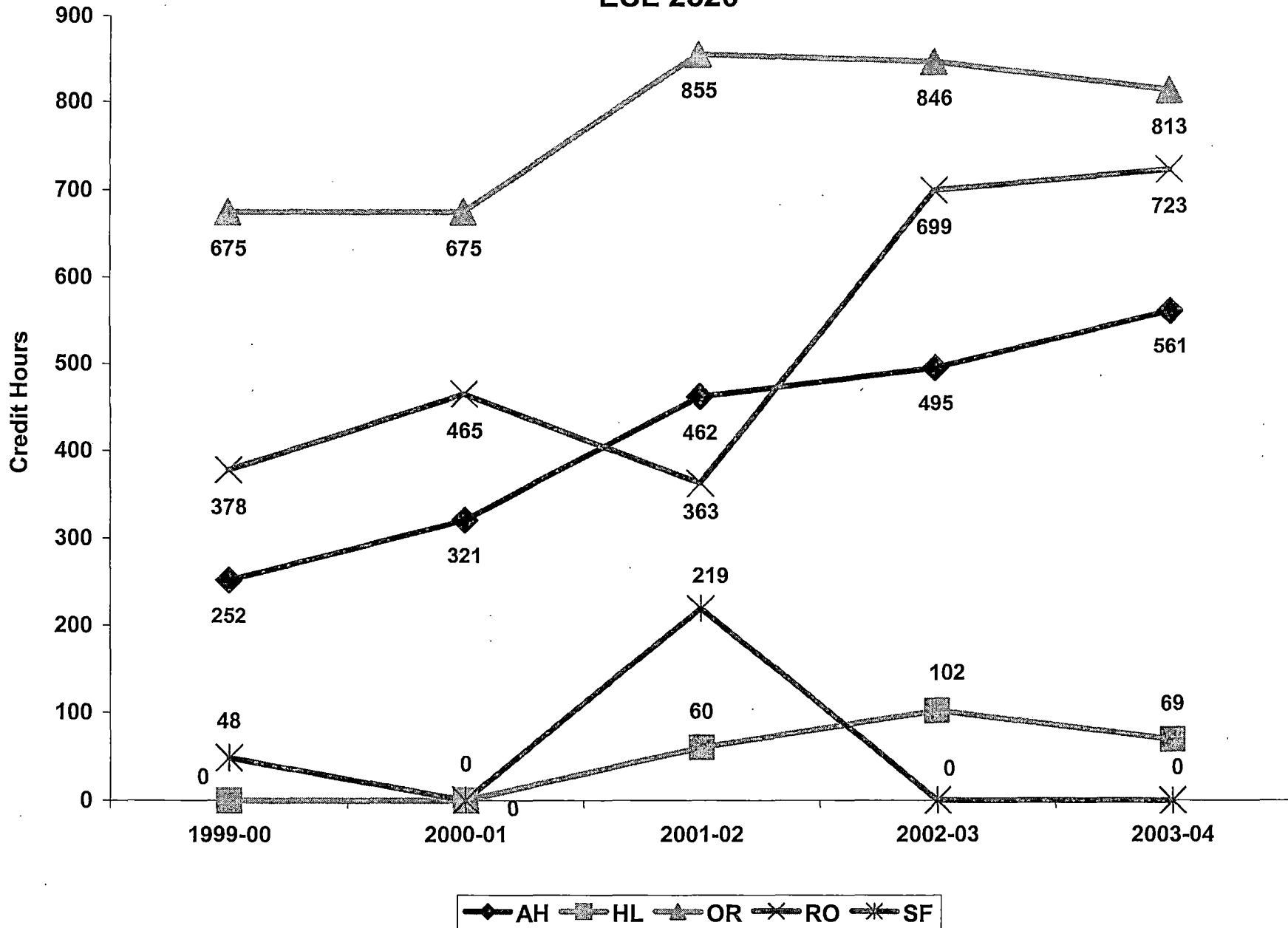


ESL Credit Hours by Course ESL 2510

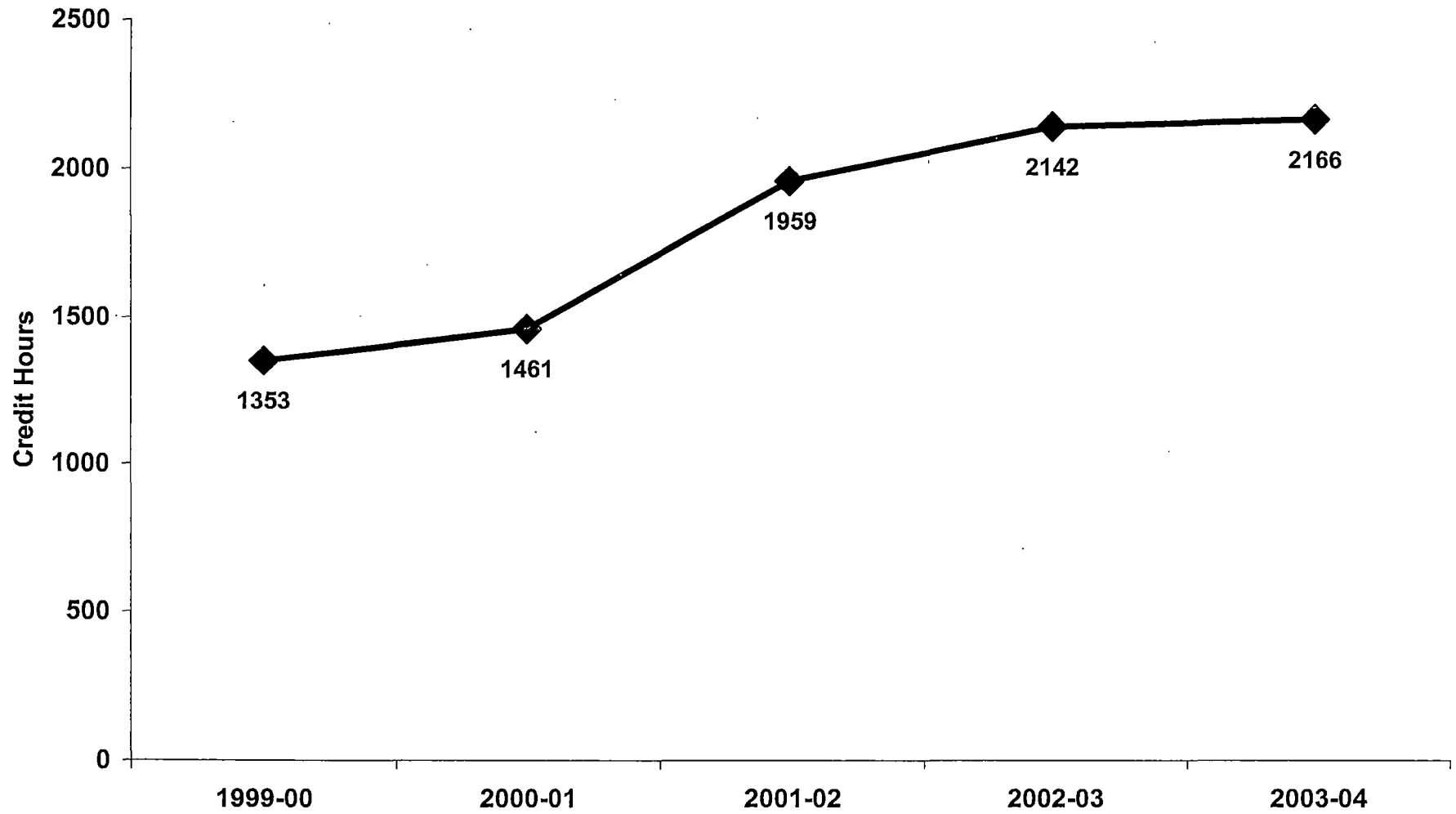

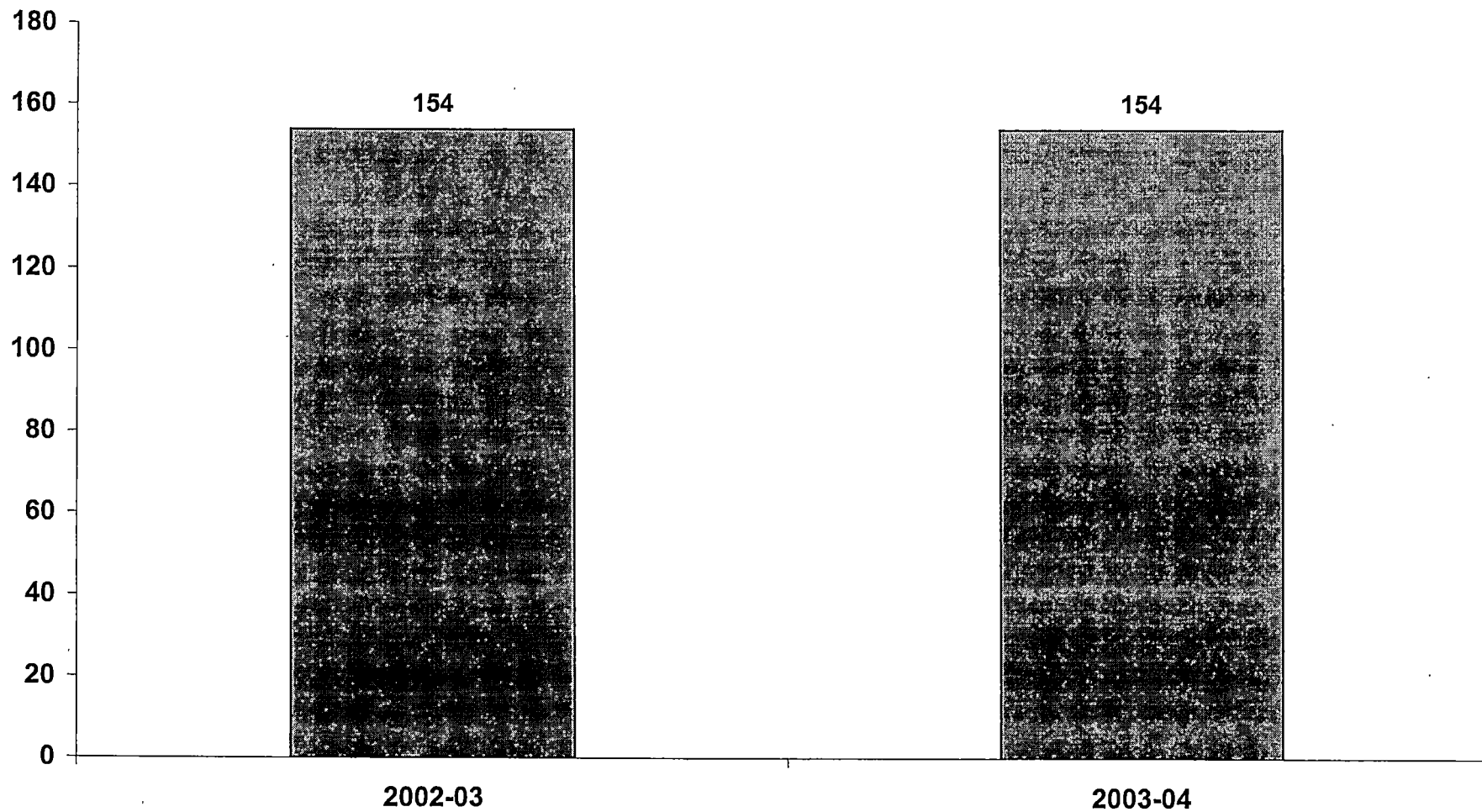


Immigration Status Unduplicated Headcount College Wide

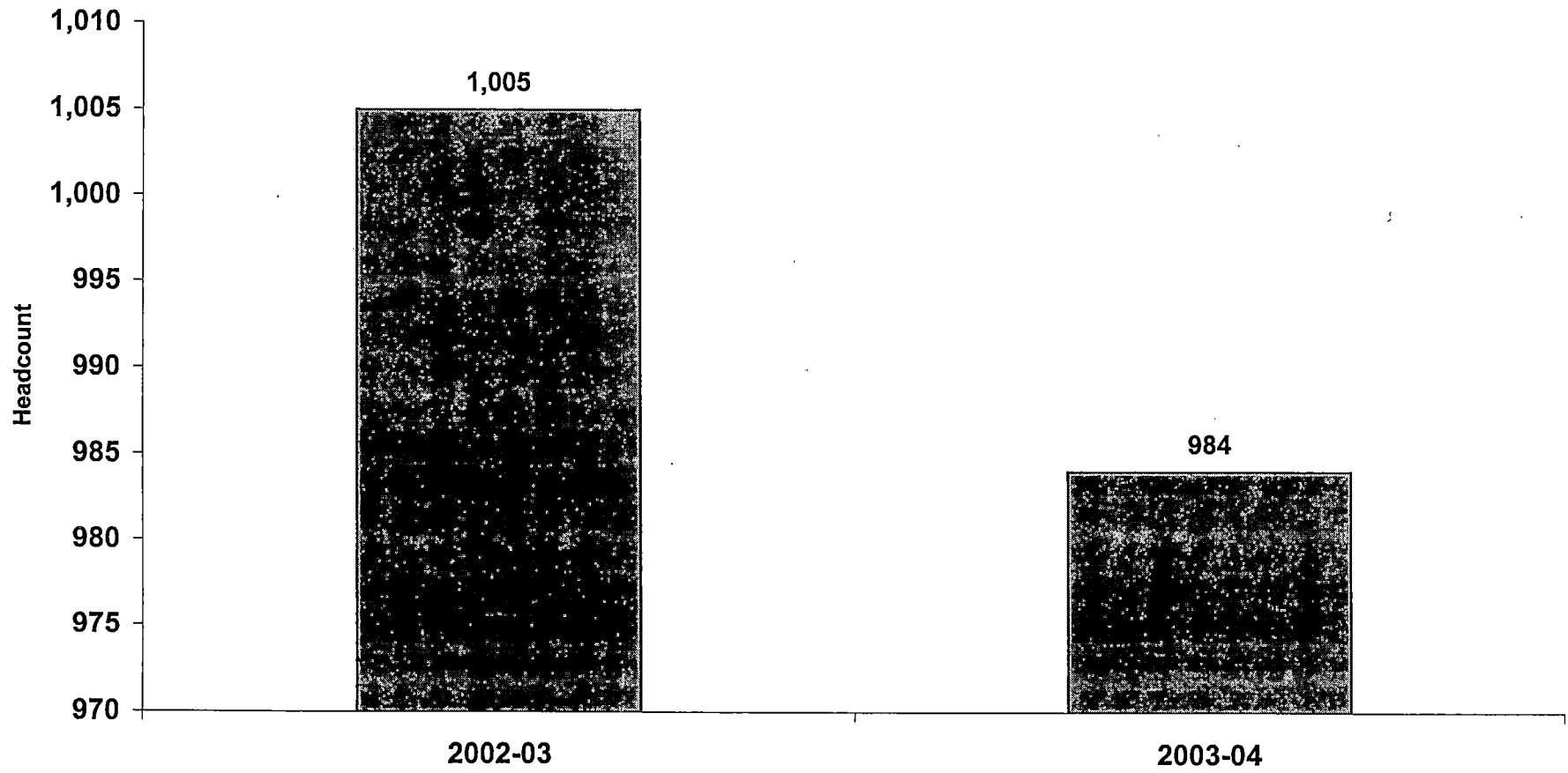

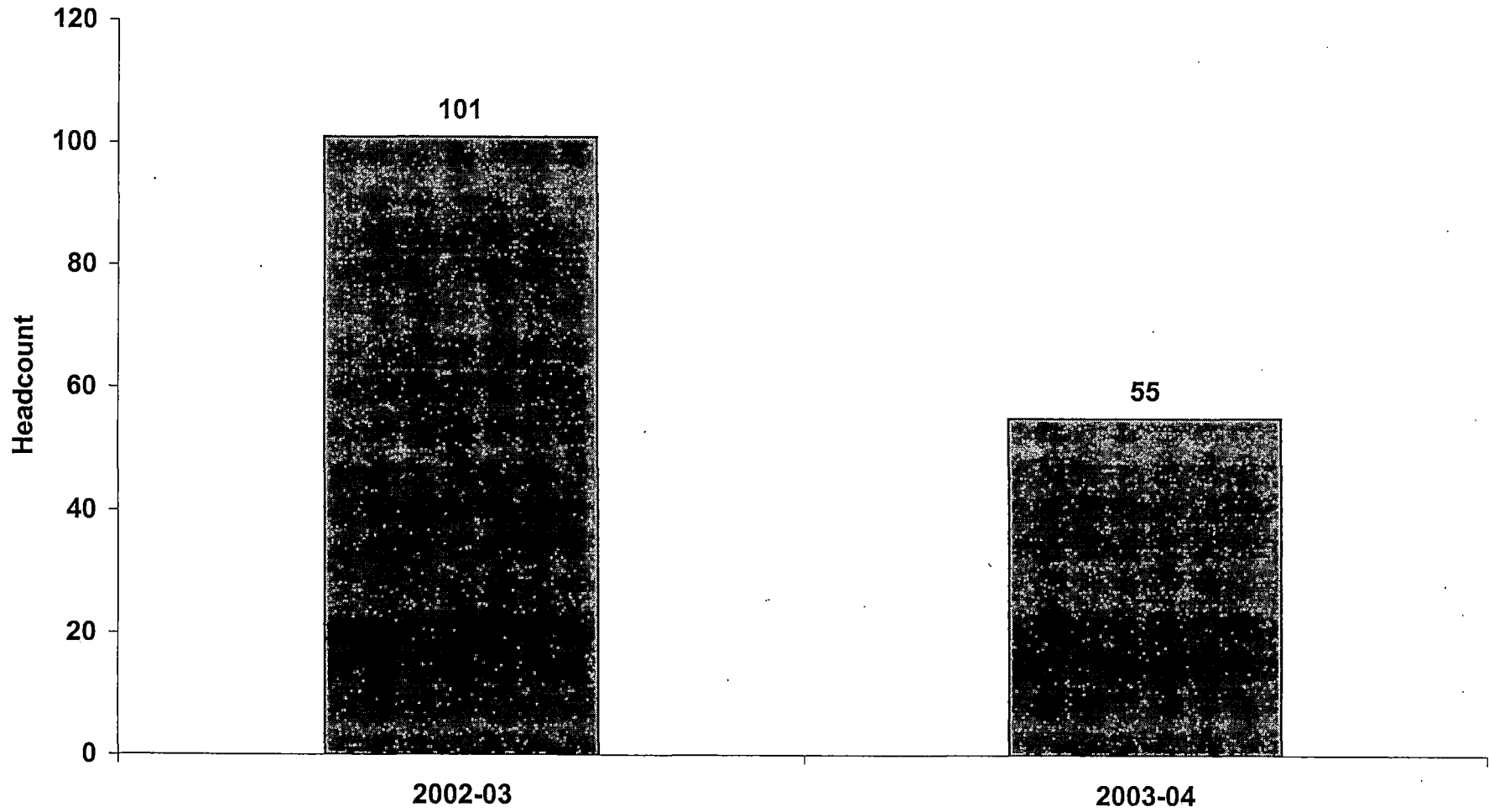

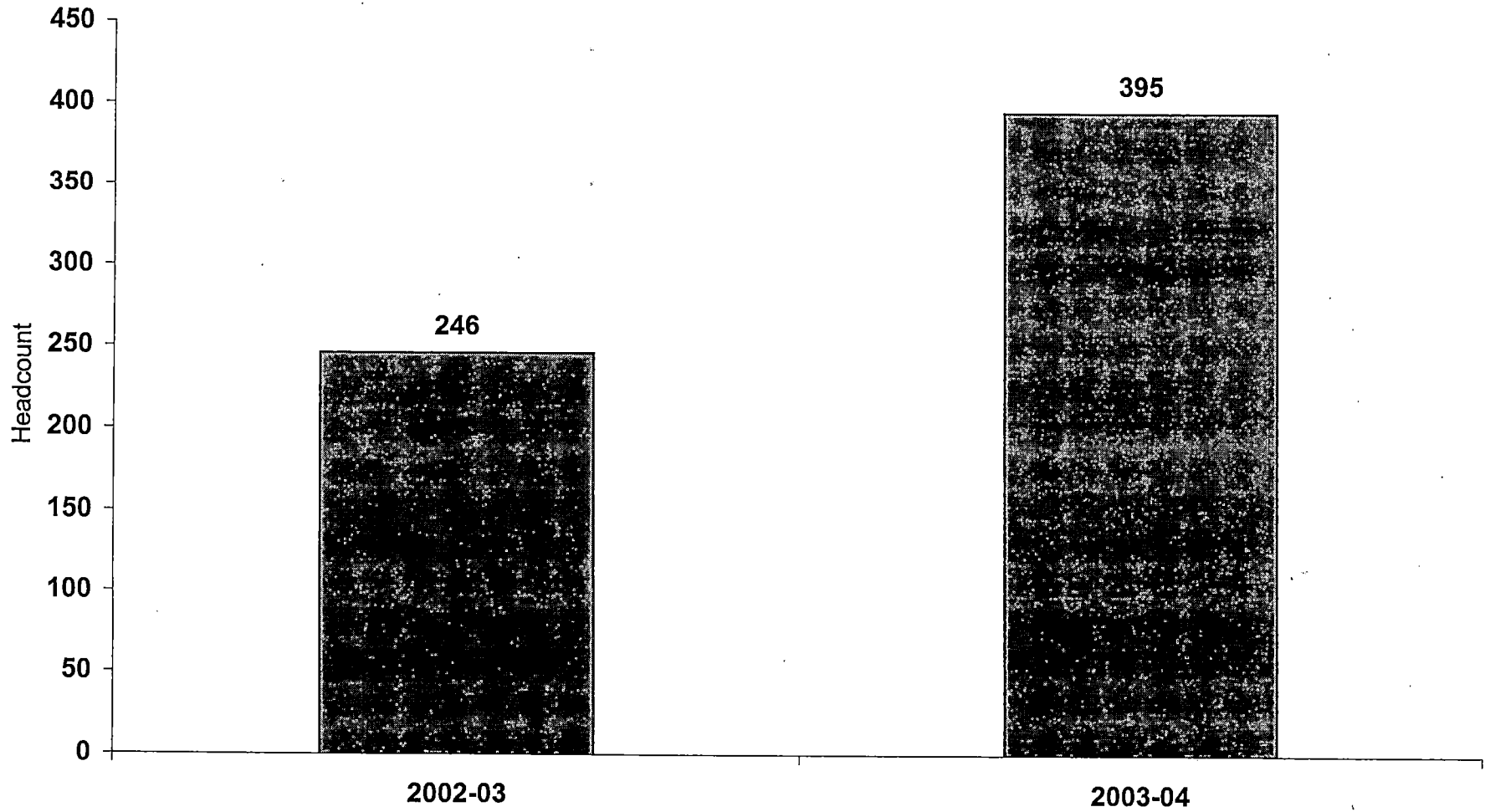
**Immigration Status

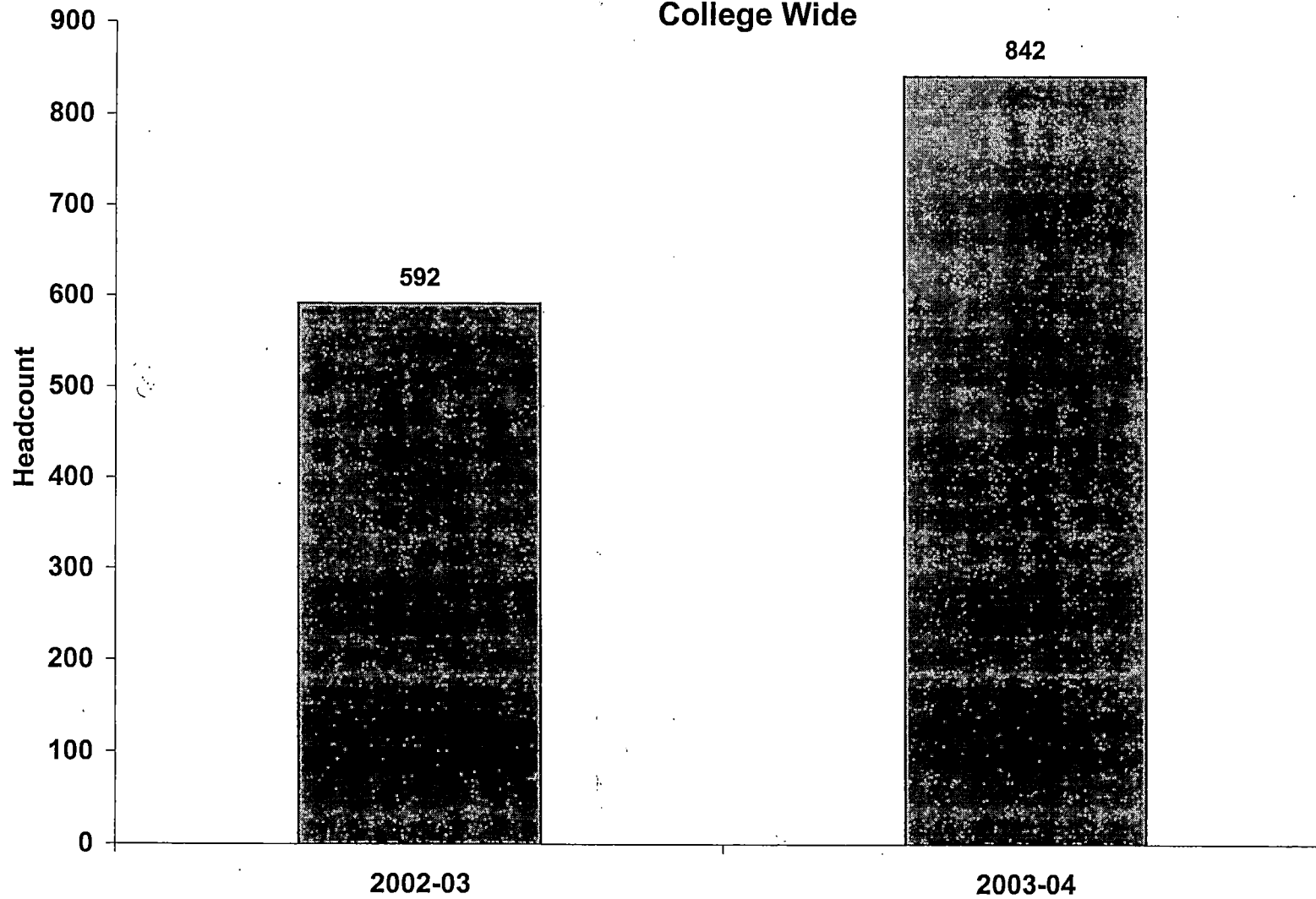

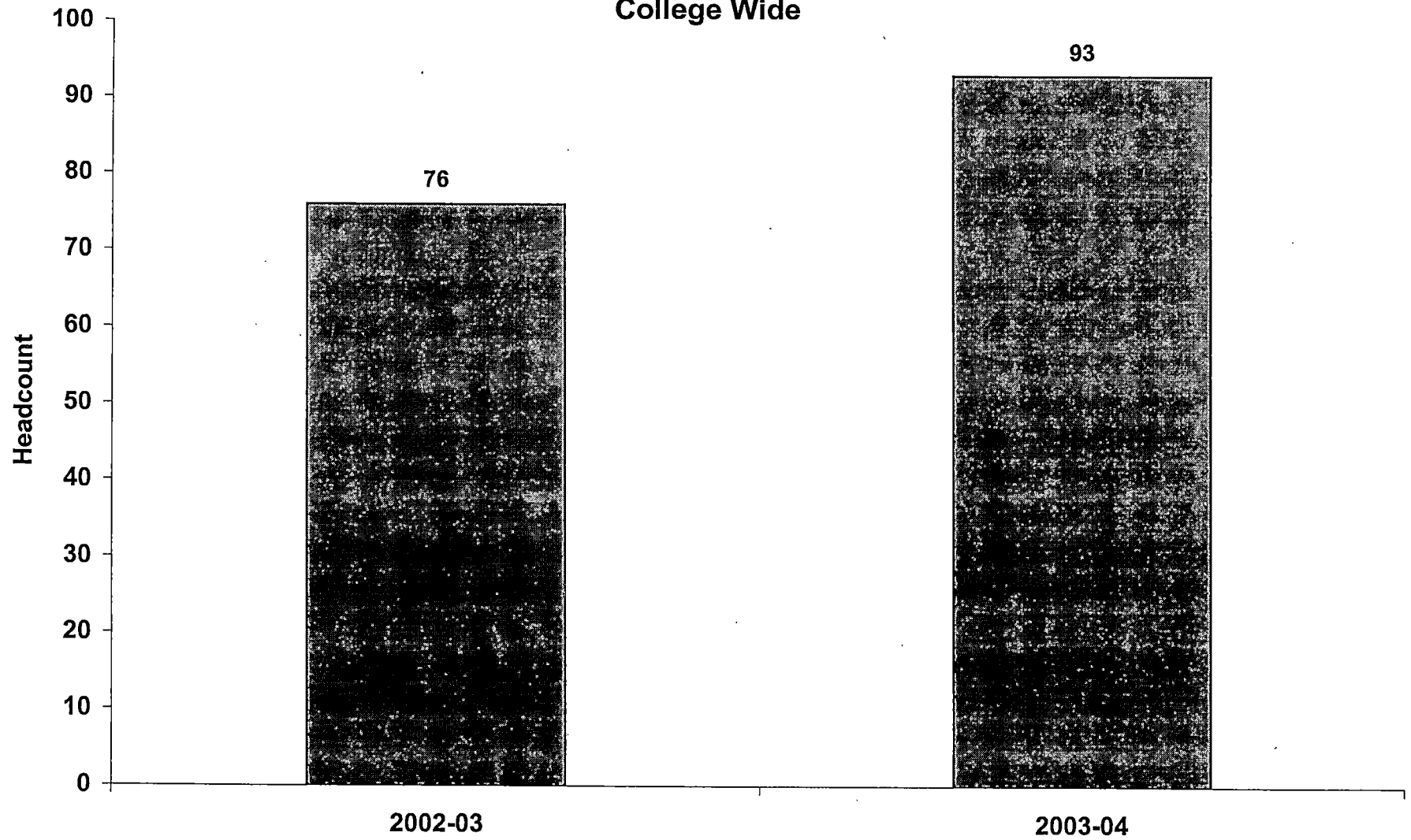
