# Paralegal (PLG) Program: In-Class Survey Data Four Term Analysis: Spring '01, Fall '01, Winter '02 and Fall '02

**Preliminary Report**

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#### **Executive Summary**

- The data represented by Spring '01 is comparatively smaller than other terms (n=36). This can somewhat "skew" findings (i.e., 78% of Spring '01 intend to get Associate degree only; based on 28 of 36 respondents; in Fall '02, 49 of 79 (62%) respondents intend to get Associate degree).
- There are increasing numbers of PLG students seeking formal awards (e.g. Associates Degree and/or Certificate). Currently, there is roughly a two-third (degree), one-third (certificate) split. These findings suggest a more committed student, as well as a student who is likely to enroll for multiple terms.
- There is a steady decline in those students seeking limited knowledge gain in a specific legal area/topic, which reinforces the previous statement.
- There was a sharp decline from Spring '01 to subsequent semesters of students taking courses for personal interest (42% Spring '01 to 6% Fall '02).
- Taking courses based on employers' encouragement remains very low.
   This portion of the Marketing strategy has not yet taken root.
- Relatively high proportions of students say they are seeking a new
  position with a new employer. This may suggest a need for job-hunting
  skills, work experience through internships, mock interviewing, resume
  writing and networking gained through the program.
- One quarter of PLG students expect to transfer. This suggests the need
  to formalize articulation with four-year institutions. The main question is:
  To what extent do articulation agreements actually increase enrollment at
  OCC, or do they suggest to students that they can/should enroll in the four
  year institution rather than at OCC, especially if the articulation agreement
  is with a local institution.
- Learning about the program through their employer is non-existent. Specifically, only 8 of the total of 272 respondents over the four-term analysis period cited this as a means of learning about the program.
- Students finding out about the program through a friend/family member is on a steady decline (currently below 5%; word of mouth). This is an interesting trend and one of potential concern.

- Roughly three in ten PLG students learn about the program through college advertisement/publication. This finding suggests that we continue to use this method.
- Use of the college website appears to be steadily increasing. This may suggest that more people are turning to the Internet to find out about programs. Further, it suggests that the Paralegal web site is growing in importance as a recruitment/information tool. OCC needs to keep the site updated, include more information e.g. newsletter, faculty bio's, human interest stories (current/former students), etc.
- Over one-third of students directly contacted the College for information.
   Therefore, there may be a strong need to have major points of contact (operators, counseling departments, etc.) aware of and knowledgeable of the Paralegal program. This could also include internal communication (newsletter, memo, etc.).
- Nearly all (90%) of those surveyed over the four terms are previous OCC students.
- Sixty-seven percent of students in this analysis are 30 and older. Only 16% of students overall are between 18 and 22 years of age.
- There is very low involvement by students in legal associations.
- Similarly, there are low numbers of students who read Legal Advisor or attend State Bar conferences and ICLE seminars.
- "Other" sources of information by which students heard about the paralegal course in which they enrolled included (in order of frequency): OCC course catalog, personal interest/student research, counselors and other miscellaneous sources. (See Chart 1 on page 11.)


