2009

August: MCCA Student Success Summit in Lansing

Summer/Fall:

meetings with Kresge Fdn re: student success at OCC

Dec: MCCA alerts CCs to stay tuned re: ATD participation and funding opportunities

2010

Jan: MCCA announces that Kresge Fdn will fund Michigan CCs in ATD via national organization (MDC); Michigan CCs invited to ATD Strategy Institute

Feb: OCC forms planning group; reps attend Strategy Institute; core team formed

March 15: Proposal due to MDC

May: Notification of acceptance

Late June: ATD KickOff Institute (Austin)

July-Dec: Data & Strategy Teams formed to begin data review, consider student success needs; review best practices; present at Fall convocations/welcome back sessions and Senate
