College Academic Master Plan Committee 2009-2010 Charges

The following charges to the College Academic Master Plan Committee for the 2009-2010 academic year were recommended by the Senate Leadership group at its August retreat and modified by the committee at its November meeting:

- Monitor college academic planning and implementation. The committee will continue to both gather and distribute academic planning information. The committee will adhere to the following reporting schedule:
 - Dec. 11: Campuses report to the committee the specific portions of their plans (goals, objectives, etc.) they intend to prioritize and achieve in the coming year. This report will also include changes made to their plans and new initiatives they are pursuing that are not explicitly stated in their plans. This information will be shared at the January college senate meeting and on Infomart.
 - Feb. 1: Campuses report to the committee current progress on achieving the priorities identified in December. This report will also include changes made to their plans and new initiatives they are pursuing that are not explicitly stated in their plans. This information will be shared at the February Discipline Day gathering, the February college senate meeting, and on Infomart.
 - June 1: Campuses submit to the committee a final report on the year's achievements. This report will also include changes made to their plans and new initiatives they are pursuing that are not explicitly stated in their plans. This information will be shared at the June college senate meeting and on Infomart.
- Review the campus academic plans. This review will conclude with a report of suggested changes and adaptations.

The committee will be seeking approval of these charges at the December college senate meeting.
