

Broadcast Set For Siberia

DETROIT, Mich.—The elders of the Royal Oak church in suburban Detroit have recently announced that this congregation would underwrite the broadcast of a 15-minute program over a South Korean station.

This program is destined to reach Siberia with its hundreds of thousands of refugees and some of the great Russian seaports.

The speaker for this program will be Ukrainian born Stephen Bilak, who is a professor at North Central Christian College. He is working under the elders of the Westside church

in Cleburne, Tex., in preparing the Ukrainian broadcasts.

This broadcast will be in addition to the work that is being done under the supervision of the elders of the Westside Church of Christ, who are broadcasting 15-minutes weekly over radio Monte Carlo, one of the most powerful stations in the world.
