

Michigan Elders Make Vietnam Survey Trip

FLINT, Mich. — Two elders of the Lennon Road congre-gation in Flint recently returned from an inspection tour of Vietnamese mission programs and called for continuing efforts to reach that country with the gospel.

Amos Ponder and Waldo Tucker spent 11 days visiting several Vietnamese cities in late March and early April.

Both men said they were warmly received by the Viet-namese people. The Montagnards, people who live in Vietmountainous regions, adopted them into their village with a formal ceremony.

"Vietnam is still a troubled, war-torn country," said Pon-der. "However a missionary
