- SOAC supports the concept of developing common course outcomes, which some disciplines have already initiated. These common course outcomes (CCO) would be developed by the discipline making the expectation for specific courses (e.g., sequence courses like ENG 1501 and 1520), without compromising academic freedom. Not only will this ensure student learning is consistent in these courses, but this information will also help adjuncts understand what is expected of them.
