Strategic Outcome #2: Promote Student Success

Objective 7: Student Readiness Develop and assess programs that enhance the student success such as the initiative "Achieving the Dream."

Comments included: AtD should not be the only "such as" model to fit into this part of the master plan. If AtD fits, that would be determined after pilot projects are completed and assessment evidence is fully in place

Objective 9: Professional Development Continue to investigate, establish, implement, and assess faculty professional development in order to promote best practices that support quality academic programs.

- a. Create a faculty academy.
- b. Provide funding for continuing educational and leadership opportunities for existing faculty such as travel outside of the college community.

Comments included: How is this different from the PDTC and why are only faculty tied to student success? What about administration especially deans and our service areas?

Objective 13: Global Awareness Increase global awareness and understanding by students through curricular and extra-curricular activities.

Comments included: This is really part of an existing gen ed outcome.
