Senate Leadership Michigan Transfer Agreement Proposals

- Proposal 1: Senate Leadership recommends the creation of three teams to investigate if and how the Business Administration, Liberal Arts, and Science Associate Degrees might be altered in order to align them with the Michigan Transfer Agreement. Recommendations from these teams would be vetted through the normal Senate curricular process and would likely (as in the past) include a balloting of the entire faculty.
 - o A Science Associate Degree Team already exists. If the Senate approves this proposal, we could simply endorse the currently existing Science team to continue its work.
