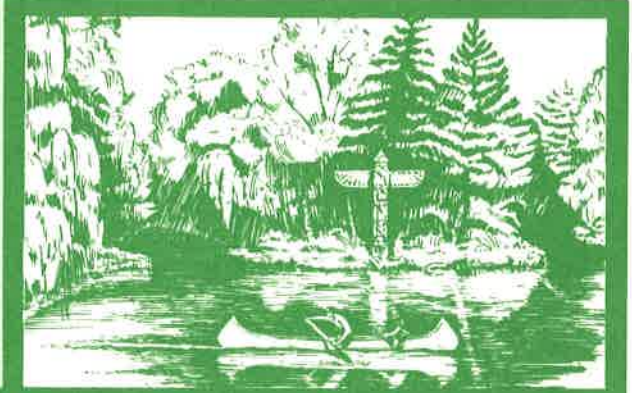

Chapel - Student Center Construction Starting Soon

Winter ground-breaking for a student center addition and a new chapel building will highlight the second semester. The construction follows several major campus renovations over the past three years.

The student center portion will about triple the current space available. The facility will be named the Utley Student Center in honor of L. C. and Elizabeth Utley. The student Body Association is currently raising funds for furnishings.

Chapel plans feature a unique layout that can within minutes be converted into three lecture rooms. Two sections, one on each side, are tiered and face the center. Permanent theatre seating with folding tablet arms serve these sections. The center section, with movable seating, faces a stage.

With the moving of chapel to the new facility, the current cafeteria will all become cafeteria space. The entire new construction, like the present cafeteria, will overlook the campus lakes.

Men's Residence Hall 1 received a complete new interior this past summer. Barbier Hall was completely redecorated, and the Multi-Purpose Hall received new carpeting. New decorator blinds were recently installed in all three. Further improvements for better dorm living are planned.

The MCC Board of Directors has approved the beginning of a Bachelor's degree in Bible studies. Tentative plans call for adding the third year next fall, and the fourth year the following fall. Details will be available later.

Pride and Prejudice, the year's first drama production, ended with a standing ovation. Don't miss Brigadoon, a Scottish folklore musical, this coming February.

Autumn, a five-member singing group, is available for performances. Their selections include both popular and religious music. Contact the MCC Admissions Office if you need some good entertainment!

Over 88% of the current student body is receiving financial aid. They average over \$1800 each. Students entering college in the fall of 1977 are encouraged to submit aid forms in January.

Reading lab facilities have expanded to include advance skim and scan techniques. The program continues to help improve student reading skills.
