## Reunions and crowning highlight Homecoming

Saturday began with a chorus reunion breakfast served by the current A Capella Chorus, followed by Alumni Chapel. A record group of former students gathered for the annual Alumni Luncheon preceding the basketball game against Jordan Valley College.

During halftime ceremonies at the game, Diane Conner of Gladwin, Michigan was crowned Homecoming Queen. Queen Diane's court included Kari Dorsey of Utica, Michigan; Willicia Payne of Bellwood, Illinois; Pam Pierson of Grand Blanc, Michigan; and Debbie Shockey of Canton, Ohio. Following the game, students returned to the residence halls to prepare for their annual Homecoming Banquet, while alumni met in the Utey Student Center for a final reception to close the day.

### Library development continues on faculty's winter Beautiful Day

Cheering continued into the halftime of February 5th's basketball game against Grand Rapids School of Bible and Music as MCC President Gilfilen declared the following day "Beautiful Day." Classes for the day were dismissed in lieu of sleeping late, ice skating, and doughnut making.

As the students took the day off, faculty members converged in the library to pour over prospective book lists. The instructors prepared requests for new books related to their respective courses and areas of study. Their efforts contributed to the preparation of a major book purchase for the library.

Over the past two years, new microfiche readers, additional shelving, new individual study systems, and 6,091 volumes have been added to the library. The college has established a six-year plan to increase the total holdings of the library by at least 50%. Current volumes number 35,589.
