Academics at Michigan Christian College

Accreditation. Academic work at MCC is accredited by the North Central Association.

Degree Programs. You may choose between a variety of degree programs at MCC. Some are liberal arts degrees which provide the basic core of courses that are required in the first two years of practically any four-year degree. Others are occupational degrees which prepare students for immediate employment after MCC.

B.R.E. Degree. Students desiring a four-year degree in Bible may obtain the Bachelor of Religious Education degree from MCC with a major in Christian Ministry or Biblical Studies.

Liberal Arts Degrees. An Associate in Arts degree from MCC provides the necessary foundation for a Bachelor of Arts degree in such areas as Art, Business, Communications, Education, English, History, Home Economics, Journalism, Law, Music, Psychology, Sociology, and Speech. Those interested in such areas as Biology, Chemistry, Computer Science, Engineering, Mathematics, Medicine, Nursing, and Physical Education may obtain the necessary foundation courses for a Bachelor of Science degree with an Associate in Science degree from MCC.

Occupational Degrees. You may seek employment immediately following two years at MCC by obtaining an Associate in Applied Science degree with a major in Accounting, Child Care, Computer Information Systems, Cosmetology Management, Executive Secretarial, General Business, General Secretarial, Homemaking, Legal Assistance, Legal Secretarial, or Word Processing.

Technical Courses. Those desiring special courses during their stay at MCC may take them at Oakland University or Oakland Community College.
