Elizabeth Dole



In Elizabeth Dole's remarkable public service career, she served five United States Presidents and led the nation's largest philanthropic organization.

A native of Salisbury, North Carolina, Mrs. Dole graduated with distinction from Duke University. She received her law degree from Harvard Law School, and holds a masters in education and government from Harvard.

Mrs. Dole was a member of the Federal Trade Commission for five years. She served two years as Assistant to President Reagan for Public Liaison.

Mrs. Dole was a Deputy Assistant to the President in the White House Office of Consumer Affairs. It was there that she began a career-long dedication to public safety, for which she received the National Safety Council's Distinguished Service Award in 1989.

In February 1983, Mrs. Dole joined President Reagan's Cabinet as Secretary of Transportation-the first woman to hold that position.

Mrs. Dole was sworn in by President Bush as this nation's 20th Secretary of Labor in January of 1989. As Labor Secretary, Mrs. Dole served as the President's chief advisor on labor and work force issues.

In 1991, Mrs. Dole received the North Carolina Award for her outstanding accomplishments and contributions in public service. In 1993 she received the North Carolina Press Association's first "North Carolinian of the Year" award, and received the Radcliffe College Medal for her outstanding accomplishments.

Until January of 1999, when she became a candidate for her party's nomination to be President of the United States, Mrs. Dole led the country's largest philanthropic organization, the American Red Cross. As president of the American Red Cross, Mrs. Dole oversaw nearly 32,000 staff members and more than 1.3 million volunteers who comprise the world's foremost humanitarian organization.

In 1992, Mrs. Dole launched an initiative to reach out to youth who are at risk of not succeeding because of social and/or economic disadvantages. The goals are to involve all youth in Red Cross training and give them structured opportunities for success through education while providing community service.

For her many contributions to the health and welfare of humanity, the Gallup Poll named Elizabeth Dole one of the world's ten most admired women.
