RC is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission of the North Central Association (30 N. LaSalle St., Chicago, IL 60602 — 800.621.7440), the same organization that provides accreditation to every major educational institution in the central United States. RC currently offers degree options in over 50 areas of study, and is in the process of developing a Masters program in Religious Education.

In addition to the traditional classroom, learning opportunities are also available in several non-traditional forms. Summer and winter field studies are offered for intensive hands-on experience, such as the Science department's annual summer expedition to the Badlands of South Dakota. Global studies are also offered, with a summer study program in Aberdeen, Scotland, and a semester abroad in Munich, Germany set to launch in the fall of 2004.
