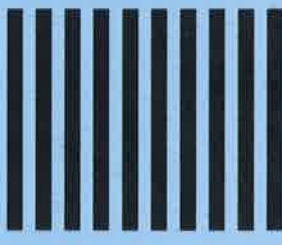

Like most schools, Rochester College offers degree options delivered in convenient evening and weekend accelerated programs.

But Rochester College is focused on giving you more.

#### Flexible Scheduling

With accelerated classes in the evenings, on weekends, and online, Rochester College helps you step ahead of the competition. Evening classes generally meet 6:00-10:00pm and weekend classes meet 8:00am-12:00pm or 12:30-4:30pm. Classes meet once a week for eight weeks, allowing students who have finished their foundation credits to complete their degree in just twelve months. However, you can set your own pace. With Rochester College, stepping forward with your education doesn't mean falling back in the rest of your life.

#### Transfer Friendly

Our generous transfer policies respect the steps you have already taken. With Rochester College, you can transfer up to 90 credits from any regionally accredited college or university. You can also earn credit for learning obtained through work experience by building a portfolio or taking exams. Professional certificates and training can also be evaluated for potential college credit. At Rochester College, you will be on the most efficient path to graduation.

#### Convenient Locations

With four locations in the Detroit Metro area, Rochester College is located near where you work and live. Our main campus is in Rochester Hills. We are also located at the Macomb Community College University Center in Clinton Township, Mott Community College University Center in Flint, and Specs Howard School of Broadcast Arts in Southfield.

#### Financial Aid

Many sources of financial assistance are available to meet your financial needs, and our financial aid office will assist you in locating them. The Financial Aid Office can provide detailed descriptions of programs, qualifications and application processes to obtain the necessary aid.

#### DEGREE OFFERINGS

##### BS Organizational Leadership and Communication

The Organizational Leadership and Communication program is comprised of a versatile curriculum that builds upon previously completed course work in specialized or technical fields. It specifically focuses on building the qualitative skills necessary for various leadership roles within small or large organizations.

##### BBA Management

The Bachelor of Business Administration degree completion program offers a broad-based and versatile education in business management. Courses focus on the most pressing issues facing business and industry today. Within the Management Major you can select one of three different tracks: General Management, Human Resources, or Marketing.

##### BS Counseling Psychology

The Counseling Psychology degree completion program is designed for adult students pursuing a career in a mental health field. Most students who complete this program will choose to continue on to graduate school for further training toward licensure as a psychologist, psychotherapist, professional counselor, or social worker.

##### BS Early Childhood Education

The Early Childhood Education degree completion program is for people who are currently employed in the early childhood field (Head Start, preschools, daycares, etc.) and is designed to help prepare you for leadership roles. The curriculum focuses on growth and development of young children, the influence of family dynamics, and education patterns of young children. Leadership, reporting and legal issues are also explored. This program does not qualify for state teacher certification.

##### BS Mass Communication

The Bachelor of Science in Mass Communication degree completion program provides you with a unique educational opportunity through a partnership between Rochester College and Specs Howard School of Broadcast Arts.

The program incorporates the technical training in either radio or video production at Specs Howard School with in-depth explorations of theory and scholarship in media at Rochester College. You can select a Broadcasting or Public Relations major.

##### BS Biblical Studies

The Bachelor of Science in Biblical Studies degree completion program supports formal preparation for Christian ministry or advanced instruction in Biblical studies. The program provides a diverse curriculum including textual, historical, doctrinal, and professional ministry courses.

Along with the program core courses, you may choose one of two tracks in either ministry or Biblical language (both may be taken if so desired). If you are interested in the Masters in Religious Education program you must take the Biblical languages track.
