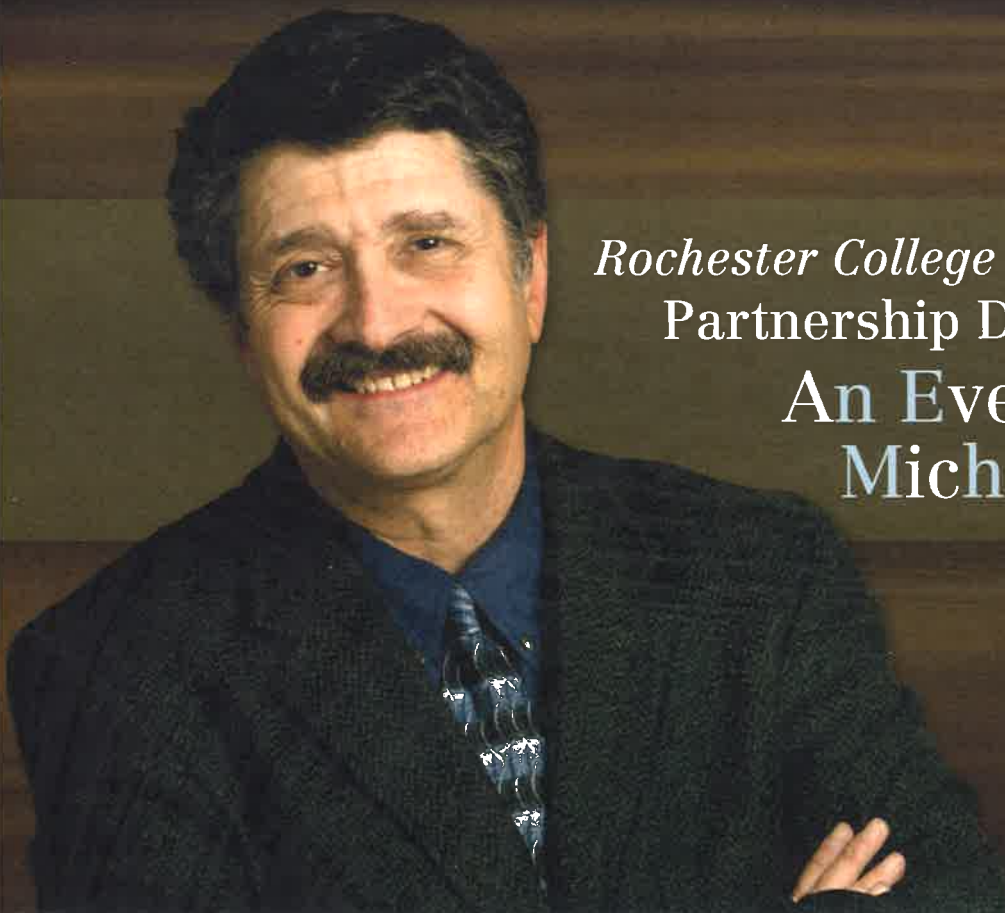

Michael Medved is a nationally syndicated radio host, best-selling author, and veteran film critic. His daily three-hour broadcast reaches over four million listeners on more than 200 stations across the country. The size of his audience ranks his show as one of the top five political talk shows in the United States.

Born in Philadelphia and educated in San Diego and Los Angeles public schools, Medved attended Yale as a National Merit Scholar and graduated with honors as an American history major. He attended Yale Law School with classmates Bill and Hillary Clinton before going to work as a political speech writer and consultant for political candidates and office-holders.
