## Kenneth Starr



Uniquely qualified to address “The Role of Christian Education in a Secular Culture,” Kenneth Starr has blended a career in law, education, and public service. He has authored more than 25 publications, including the book “First Among Equals.”

Prior to accepting his current role as president of Baylor University, Starr served as dean and professor of law at Pepperdine University. He has also taught courses for the New York University School of Law, George Mason University School of Law, and Chapman Law School.

A former solicitor general of the United States, Starr has argued 36 cases before the United States Supreme Court. He has also served as a United States circuit judge, and was appointed to serve as independent counsel for five investigations including the Whitewater case. He still provides counsel to the law firm of Kirkland & Ellis LLP, where he was a partner from 1993 to 2004.
