Scott Hamilton

Scott Hamilton, the most recognized male figure skating star in the world, joins us this evening to talk about "God and the Human Spirit."

In addition to winning the Gold medal at the 1984 Olympics, Hamilton won four consecutive U.S. Championships, four consecutive World Championships, and 70 other figure skating titles. His awards and honors include an Emmy nomination, induction into the U.S. Olympic Hall of Fame and the World Figure Skating Hall of Fame. He also inspires others as a speaker, philanthropist, and cancer and pituitary brain tumor survivor. Recently, Hamilton released his inspirational book "The Great Eight" and returned to the ice at age 51 before conquering a recurrence of a brain tumor in 2010.

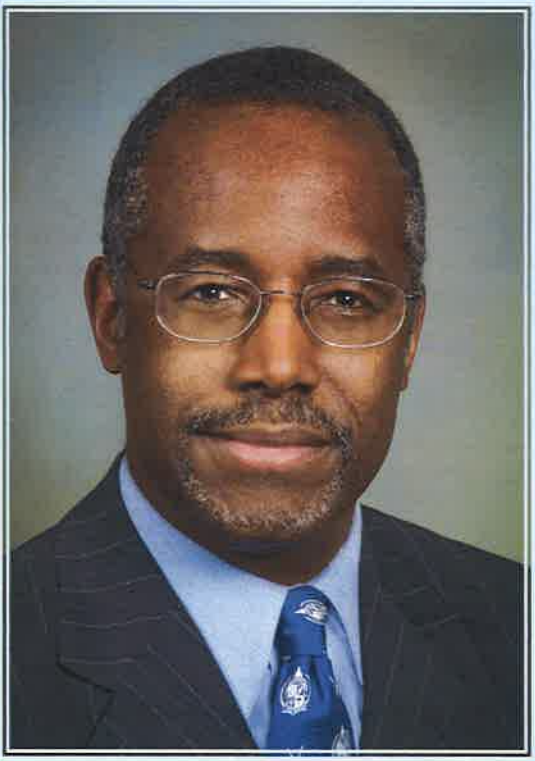
