**Minutes for 5/6/97 Meeting**

**System Updates**

In Anaclare Evans's (WSU) absence, F. White offered a summary of the DALNET Project Managers Meeting, which he attended on May 5, 1997. Topics included: OViD proposal for DALNET, database issues, Distributed Printing Policy, and the NOTIS LMS Release 6.3.1. The target date for NOTIS 6.3.1 installation has been extended to the July 4<sup>th</sup> weekend, rather than Memorial Day weekend as originally planned.

**DALNET Users Group Meeting Feedback**

B. Ho distributed a report summarizing the completed evaluations of participants in the DALNET Users Group Meeting held April 8, 1997 at WSU. As can be seen in the attached report, the meeting was rated favorably, with most participants rating the program as "very good," "good," and "outstanding." The suggestion was made, however, by D. Roe (UDM) to change the name of future events from "DALNET Cataloging and Authority Control Users Group Meeting" to "DALNET Cataloging and Authority Control Users Group Forum" Most committee members agreed that the new name will better reflect the nature of the event.

**CLARR Demonstration**

B. Ho presented a demonstration of CLARR, the cataloger's toolkit for the committee. Committee members who would like to obtain the CLARR program for use at their institutions were urged to contact the DALNET office. B. Ho will prepare program copies and installation instructions.

**Review of Standard Documents**

The Committee completed its review of "DALNET Bibliographic and Authority Database Standards" (2/89). Suggested revisions will be incorporated into a new draft by A. Lim and will be distributed to committee members before the next meeting.

In addition, the suggestion was made by A. Lim to incorporate many of the items in the existing DALNET document "Basic Operating Premises" into the next document slated for review, "Name/Series Authority in NOTIS" (11/90). The remaining information in the "Basic Operating Premises" could then be revised and turned into a new "Conflict Resolution Policy." A. Lim offered to compose a draft of this proposed "Conflict Resolution Policy" and distribute it to committee members for review before the next meeting.

The DALNET Cataloging and Authority Control Users Group Meeting took place at Kresge Auditorium, Purdy/Kresge Library, Wayne State University on April 8, 1997. Forty-three people attended this one-day meeting.

The meeting concentrated upon three major areas: cataloging electronic materials, Cataloger's Workstation, and Cataloging Workflow issues.

According to the ratings on the returned evaluation forms, four people rated the program as outstanding, eighteen said it was very good, and seven rated the program as good. No one rated the program as fair or poor. In general, people believe the information obtained that day will help them perform their functions more effectively. Among the sessions, "Issues in Cataloging Electronic Resources" presented by the guest speaker from University of Michigan, Head of Special Format Cataloging, Bonnie Dede, was the most popular and was well received. Topics that the group would like to see addressed in the future include: using NOTIS reports to identify database problems and updates on plans for the new library system.
