Frequently Asked Questions

What is healthcalendar.org?

healthcalendar.org is a place for registered health related agencies and programs to list upcoming events that they sponsor and are open to public participation or agency clientele. healthcalendar.org is a service of DALNET (Detroit Area Library Network).

Each event listing consists of the name of the organization sponsoring the event, the name of the event, an optional description of the event, and an optional link to a Web page containing information about the organization. All participating agencies **must** serve one of the following counties: Livingston, Macomb, Monroe, Oakland, St. Clair, Washtenaw, Wayne.

What data is available in healthcalendar.org?

Event information is added by the sponsoring organizations. DALNET is not responsible for errors of content, changes, omissions or oversight with respect to any event on healthcalendar.org.

How far in advance can events be added?

The recommended listing of events is up to one year in advance. However, it is possible to list for several years in advance.

Can events be modified?

Yes, events can be modified or deleted. It is not necessary to delete past events.

Who can add events?

Anyone who represents a registered agency or organization can add events, if they have the password.
