Purpose

The purpose the "Find Programs Report" is to bridge projected occupation growth with Oakland Community College's (OCC) programs of study. This report lists the top twenty (20) occupations projected to have the most growth (or change) within the Royal Oak and Southfield Campuses' 10 mile radius.

Method

Two (2) different data elements were used for this project. The Economic Modeling Specialists (EMSI) database was used for regional economic and labor market projection data, while the Office of Institutional Research supplied OCC's completer data for the last few years. The EMSI query isolated occupation projections for the 10 mile radius around the Royal Oak and Southfield Campuses, referencing occupations that need short-term on-the-job training through a bachelor's degree education. The timeline used for this study was 2006 through 2012, which allowed historical information from 2006 through 2009 to be used for a more realistic projection. The graduation data references only 'credit' type programs of study; therefore OCC's non-credit efforts are not represented in this report.

Summary of Findings

Healthcare occupations are projected to grow the most in the Royal Oak and Southfield Campuses' 10 mile radius from 2006 to 2012:

- Home Health Aides (#1; 1,876 job change)
- Registered Nurses (#2; 1,569 job change)
- Personal and Home Care Aides (#3; 1,414 job change)
- Nursing Aides, Orderlies, and Attendants (#4; 923 job change)

OCC currently offers credit programs to support these occupations listed below. However, it may be important to review these programs to determine if they meet the demands of the students (offering enough sections, etc.) to support these occupations:

- · Registered Nurses (#2)
- Medical Assistants (#7)
- Social and Human Service Assistants (#9)
- Pharmacy Technicians (#16)
- Computer Software Engineers, Applications (#17)
- Network Systems and Data Communications Analysts (#18)
- Dental Assistants (#19)

Of the top twenty (20) occupations in the region, there are a few occupations that indicate needing a Bachelor's Degree level of education. Royal Oak Campus might want to consider expanding course offerings for transferring credits to support these occupations:

- Personal Financial Advisor (#5)
- Medical and Public Health Social Workers (#11)
- Property, Real Estate, and Community Association Managers (#13)
- Securities, Commodities, and Financial Services Sales Agents (#14)
- Child, Family, and School Social Workers (#20)

From the top twenty (20) occupations, below are the occupations not currently supported by any OCC credit programs <u>or</u> for which OCC has not indicated any completers / graduates in the last few years:

- Home Health Aides (#1)
- Personal and Home Care Aides (#3)
- Nursing Aides, Orderlies, and Attendants (#4)
- Real Estate Brokers (#6)
- Security Guards (#8)
- Real Estate Sales Agents (#10)
- Child Care Workers (#12)
- Psychiatric Aides (#15)

The information below is the 'Job Change Ranking' column, which indicates the order of the occupations' projected change, descending. Below each Occupation Title are Instructional Programs (with CIP Cc ese are the programs of study, some of which are not offered at OCC, associated with each occupation. In some cases there is more than one program of study for an occupation.

C graduate data are also included in this table, referencing academic years 2005-06 through 2007-08. This shows the number of OCC students who graduated in each program for the ademic year. An asterisk (*) in the SOC Code column signifies the fact that OCC has had completers in these programs.
