At its meeting in June the Board will review a timeline and and framework for project plans to move forward with a software migration in the future. Investigations and planning include the possible adoption of a discovery system catalog and a new library automation platform. After the Board adopts a time frame and sets an agenda for moving the consortium into the future, the whole of the DALNET membership will be invited to participate in the review and selection of a new system for DALNET. [member login required]</p> <h3>Committee Updates</h3> <p>The Reciprocal Borrowing Committee had its first meeting on March 12, 2012 and is working to complete a draft for a revised DALNET Reciprocal Borrowing policy for use with the union catalog. The policy should be forwarded to the Project Managers this month. They will then begin working on new procedures for lending materials through the union catalog. The office will provide profile forms for interested libraries to fill out so that this project can get underway. DALNET plans to launch reciprocal borrowing through the union catalog in mid-to-late summer. The committee's next meeting will be Wednesday, April 4th, from 2-4 PM at Walsh College, Troy.
