May this evening be a celebration of the power of collaboration, love, and the pursuit of knowledge through your generous giving now and into the future.



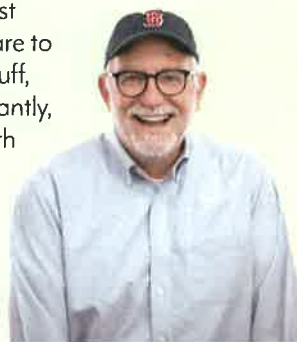
