# United Way Demographics (1990 Census)

- \* The communities with the largest populations in the service area are Pontiac (71,166) and Waterford Township (66,692).
- \* Pontiac has the largest minority population in the service area; over 42% of Pontiac residents are African American, and 8% are Hispanic. Thus, in Pontiac, the non-white population exceeds 50% of total population.
- \* The communities with the largest proportion of residents under 18 are Brandon Township (30.5%), Independence Township (26.8%), Orion Township (26.8%), Ortonville (30.0%), Oxford Township (28.2%), and Pontiac (30.5%).
- \* The communities with the smallest proportion of residents under 18 are Clarkston (18.9%) and Sylvan Lake (18.7%).
- \* Pontiac has the highest proportion of residents living in poverty (26%); poverty rates in all other communities within the service area are well below 10%. Oakland County as a whole has a poverty rate of 6%.
- \* For all reported communities, poverty rates for families with female heads of household are considerably higher than the overall poverty rates. Of female-headed households, nearly 50% live at or below the poverty level in Pontiac (48.5%). Other service area communities are also plagued by extremely high poverty rates for female-headed households: Oxford Township (22.1%), Brandon Township (18.2%), Orion Township (18.2%), and Auburn Hills (17.8%). The poverty rate for female-headed households in Oakland County as a whole is 19.4%.
- \* Female-headed households with young children (under 5 years of age) are more likely to be living in poverty than those with older children. For instance, in the Village of Clarkston, 15% of female headed households with children under 18 are living at or below the poverty level, while in the same community, 50% of female-headed households with children under 5 are living in poverty.
- \* The highest poverty rates for female-headed households with young children are found in Ortonville (69.2%), Pontiac (68.8%), Oxford Township (54.7%), and Brandon Township (54.3%). The poverty rate for female headed households with small children in Oakland County overall is 50.0%.
- \* Nearly 60% of Oakland County women over 16 years of age are in the workforce. The highest female employment rate is found in Auburn Hills (68.8%), and the lowest female employment rate is in Pontiac (52.9%).
- \* Over 80% of all Oakland County men over 16 are employed. Lake Angelus has the highest adult male employment rate (87%), and Pontiac has the lowest (67.2%).
- \* The highest per capita income is found in Lake Angelus (\$52,169), and the lowest is in Pontiac (\$9,847).
- \* Pontiac has the highest ratio of high school dropouts to high school graduates: for every 100 high school graduates in Pontiac, there are reportedly 24.2 dropouts.
