## Credit Hour Trends Report

Once credit hour data has been put into the ACS-6 report, we can update and print the credit hour trends report. The report is at I:\Enrollment\1Reports\Credit Hour Trend.xls

Open the file. Click on Enable Macros.

Click Yes to open as Read Only if you're just going in to print reports. Otherwise, if you need to make changes or update the spreadsheet Click NO.

When asked if you want to update all linked information, Click NO

### Printing Reports

There are two different reports that can be printed. To **print the report for a specific discipline (such as Accounting)**, go to the first tab of the workbook called Dialog Box. In the Course Prefix Code Box type the course prefix (ACC in this example). Then press ENTER. This will change all the relevant instances to Accounting-related data.

There is one graph that needs to be manually adjusted. So, go to the 3 yr mean tab. Double click on the vertical axis of the bottom chart. In the Format Axis dialog box click on the Scale tab and adjust the values so that the data fit on the graph. Then click OK

To print the entire report for a discipline go back to the first tab called Dialog Box and click on the button that says "Print Discipline Specific Report."

To print the **college-wide report**, which is a summary of the data, but doesn't go down to the level of disciplines, simply click on the first tab called Dialog Box and click the "Print College-wide Report" button.

### Updating the Spreadsheet

After the credit hour data is available for ACS, it can be entered into the spreadsheet. Go to the Data Warehouse sheet of the workbook. Click on Column D and Insert a Column. Enter the year at the top of the column, then enter the SCH for each discipline in the appropriate cell.
