SUMMARY AND SURVEY PROCEDURES

The information presented in the following report covers graduates for the academic year ending in June 1989. The data received on graduates was gathered primarily through the use of mail and telephone/surveys. A mail survey of the June '89 graduates was conducted approximately four (4) months after their graduation date. A follow-up by telephone was utilized three (3) months after the initial mail survey to contact graduates who did not acknowledge the first mail questionnaire.

The total number of graduates in the attached tables represent degrees and certificates granted during the reporting period. Where a graduate may have received more than one degree within the reporting year, he or she was tabulated each time for the purpose of the report. The totals then provide an unofficial count and may vary slightly with the final count in the college records.

Placement status information was attained from 71.1% of the graduates receiving degrees or certificates. The survey was also utilized to introduce the graduates to the OCC Alumni Resume Referral Service. This free placement service initiated in July 1988, allows employers an opportunity to review resumes of OCC graduates for full-time professional positions. The salary status column reports the average salary for positions that are related and unrelated to their major field of study. Eighty-one percent (81%) of the reporting programs/curriculums reported higher average salaries for positions related to their field of study vs. 19% with higher average salaries in positions unrelated to their field of study. In other words, the associate degree/certificate is more than just one or two years of college, it is a specific program of study that may be required in order to be licensed, certified or otherwise elible for a particular job.

June 1989 reporting graduates showed a placement rate of 94% the "Placement Rate" is defined as the percent of responding graduates who are in categories; employed in major, employed other, continuing education, and not seeking employment.

Many hours of data validation, report formatting, and phone follow-up are required in producing this report. Acknowledgement and credit for those contributions goes to Tammy Roy, and Denise Doyle, Placement Office Secretaries and the student assistants employed in the Auburn Hills Placement Office.

The report which follows represents a composite of information on placement status of graduates as reported during the survey period following graduation. Conclusion and statistical interpretations can only be made within the framework of this study and findings reported here may not readily be comparable to other reports.








